Here is a great big “thank you” to all of you who responded to my letter sharing about my upcoming adventure into Russia. Your response was so encouraging and in the back of my heart we just knew that God would supply. It’s so exciting to know that the Body hears His voice and is also willing to obey. It’s even better to know that the folks we count dearest will get the benefit from the souls that will be saved and lives changed. The hard part now is the waiting and of course the preparation for the trip. Please be in prayer for me as I have made the commitment to lose 50 pounds before I get on board for the really long flight overseas. I also want to be healthy so that I can stay up with the energy level of all the kids.

Snezhana and I will also be going into a baby orphanage in Minsk during our first two weeks in Belarus. The babies there are not held and not changed nearly enough. They usually have very bad diaper rashes and also are not loved and held. We will be going in to hold and give them as much love and time as we can while there. Snezhana told me she plans to take baby clothes, blankets, infant and toddler toys, diaper rash ointment

and we will also buy as many disposable diapers as we can afford once there. Hot water seems to be a rare commodity in Belarus and so diapers aren’t changed nearly as often as we would here. If you’d like to send any of the items above in new or “nearly new” condition we would gladly take them in. Please do NOT send diapers as they are too bulky to carry in.

Jeff will be here for all of you (as usual) and I’m hoping you too will be available for him. He’s a terrible bachelor (hallelujah) and has a tendency to eat Oreos, peanut butter sandwiches, bananas and chocolate milk. I would get tired of that after one meal. YUCK.

My friend and interpreter, (Snezhana Noll) and her two year old daughter (Rachel) will not only make my trip easier by helping me over any language barriers, but will also help me find my way around Minsk. I in turn hope to be a blessing to them as they will need help in the airport and with mission projects that Snezhana wants to do in her native land. It is very costly for such a venture and although we’ve pretty much raised the funds I need, we want to help her as well. If you want to sow into her life as well please earmark any funds you send with the name ANA. Of course any funds that you mark for Russia will go towards getting things for the kiddos in the orphanage now that my airfare/food/lodging is covered.

Thank you again for taking the vision God has given us and running with it. We will be living in less than familiar surroundings as things are very much different in Belarus. We trust that God will help us through the changes and adjustments ahead. Please be in prayer for our trip over and for each day during our stay. The adversary would like to stop this work of love. RUSSIAN BIBLE STUDY





Working Out With Jeff

Righteousness Consciousness

Rom 5:19 *For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous.*



1 Cor. 1:30 *But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption.*

Righteousness is a condition many in the body of Christ do not believe they are in. Let me explain that statement: In the United States we have a condition that people must meet before they are allowed to live in this country. He or she must be a citizen to be in right-standing with the United States Government. A citizen of the US is given rights that are irrevocable. If you get into trouble of any kind generally the US will stand with you and be your defense. Not too many countries in this world want to try and argue with the US.

I have left this country several times but the two times I had to go through a customs booth (both coming and going) it was very eye opening. When I was done traveling abroad and was ready to come home a United States customs agent at a booth in this country met me. It is a chilling feeling standing on the "outside" of the country I love and have lived in for

nearly fifty years and be faced with the need to **prove** my citizenship. I had rights as a US citizen when I was in the states, but now it was up to me to **prove** that I am still a citizen and have to do it with the proper documentation. Without that documentation I would not have been allowed in.

We all (I'm taking for granted all reading this are US citizens) have been given certain inalienable rights and are considered equal by one standard; citizenship! The kingdom of God is no different. Have you become a citizen of the Kingdom of God? If so you have been given certain rights and privileges as such. If any evil comes against you (the devil) you have an advocate between you and judgment. Jesus is that advocate and will back you by your right-standing in His kingdom. You have been justified and are legally a free citizen of the kingdom of God. As long as you know what your rights are He will back you all the way. If not He can't, it's not that He won't, He can't. Do you know that in 1865 this nation's leaders decided to make ALL men equal and free? In spite of it there was slavery and abuse of the black people in this country for 100 years after equality and freedom was declared. Why, because men could get away with it. The black man was just as free in 1865 as he was in 1965, he just didn't believe it or stand up for the law that was on his side. Yes there were casualties of some that tried to stand up and declare themselves free Americans. There will always be wounded and casualties in any war, but the black people kept standing and kept declar-

ing their freedom. Finally the law that they knew was on their side was able to keep them free. Slowly but surely slavery and abuse of the black people in America became a rarity and continues today. Sure bad men try and get away with abuse but it is widely recognized that there is no legal slavery for any race in America and abuse of any kind is punishable. It wasn't always that way; someone had to begin declaring the rights given to him. Again the Kingdom of God is no different, many can't figure out why their life is so messed up. It is simply because they don't believe or even know what God has given to them. Because of it they never declare to the evil out there (the devil)

who they are and what they have. So basically the angels, Jesus and even God are all just waiting on us to speak the word that is ours. They wait for us to speak the promises given us and our rights and privileges as citizens of the Kingdom of God.

We have been made the righteousness of God in Christ. We are also living in the end of days. It is time for the body of Christ to “hear” the Spirit of our Father in this area of righteousness. It’s time to get rid of the sin consciousness we have all learned so well and begin to listen and learn truth from the word only! Effective Prayer



*Philemon 6 That the communication of thy faith **may become** effectual by the acknowledging of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus.*

*James 5:16 Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye **may be** healed.*

The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man

availeth much.

*1 John 5:14-15 And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, **if** we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: And **if** we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.*

Effective prayer is **conditional**. If we don’t meet the conditions it won’t be effective.

The Body of the Anointed is in a place where we must have God’s supply and intervention in our lives on a daily basis. We need to be able to tap into the substance of heaven to supply our every need.

Whether we need healing or any of the other things that God willingly provides for His children, it should be received from heaven.

One reason we don’t receive like we should from heaven is that we don’t put our total faith in God for our provision. It’s so much easier to lean to the “arm of the flesh” and depend on our own “two hands” and our minds to obtain what we want and need. Why go to God for healing if we can go to our friendly neighborhood doctor? Now mind you doctors keep folks alive, but there has never been a human doctor who has healed a single person. Sure there are lots of them who think they have that power, but basically all they do is aid the body in its God designed natural healing processes. Many times they actually do more harm in their efforts to “heal” than if the body had been left alone to heal itself. (Proverbs 3:5, Deuteronomy 8:17, Romans 8:1-13) Sadly most people only go to God when things are so bad medical science has no answer. Our faith in God should be greater than our faith in medical science. We’ve all heard folks say, “I suppose we should pray”. To which we’ve also heard in reply, “Has it come to that”? We have a good example of such a man in the bible: *2 Chron 16:12 And Asa in the thirty and ninth year of his reign was diseased in his feet, until his disease was exceeding great: yet in his disease he sought not to the LORD, but to the physicians. King Asa died because he didn’t go to God, but went to physicians.*



Whether it's financial health or physical health, we as children of God should always go first to God and get His will on the matter and not turn to Him as a "last resort". *Matt 7:11 If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?* It's about recognizing Him as our Father and going to Him for provision rather than the world. That's why folks in third world countries have so many miracles. They have no medical science to lean upon so they readily accept the healing of God when offered.

Today we have so much of the word and understanding of it available to us. We are accountable for that knowledge. We have knowledge on how to receive healing. We know how to receive financial benefits, we know how to contact heaven, we know that God is the healer, and we know that God is our provider. We have more revelation knowledge than any generation alive and we are accountable for what we do with it. If you go to a doctor you should go by faith. Before you go you should seek the face of God. Remember the woman who suffered many things of her physician and was none better? She had no other recourse until Yeshua/Jesus came on the scene. There are so many scriptures dealing with medicine, help, health and healing and we should all know them.

Luke 12:48 For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.

Luke 16:10-11 He that is faithful in that which is least is faithful also in much: and he that is unjust in the least is unjust also in much. If therefore ye have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true riches?

Prayer works according to the word. God's word is His will. He doesn't say one thing and do something differently. Our goal should be to be intimate with His will and His voice. We should have His word flowing out of us like the

living water that Yeshua/Jesus spoke of.

The effectiveness of our faith depends upon how much of the word is working in our lives. The written word of God is the blueprint; Yeshua/Jesus is the manifestation of that blueprint. He is our pattern. He was led forth by the Spirit of Compassion and so should we. Our hearts should be full of love for the Father and thus more interested in His will and in pleasing Him than anything else. Our lives should manifest His love and the expression of it should be forgiveness and love for our fellow man.

Now let me share some practical ways to have a more effective prayer life.

- ?? Don't just go to any doctor. You wouldn't take your car to just any mechanic? If you have a Ford you go to a Ford mechanic, etc. Pray and get God's take on the matter FIRST.
- ?? Spend a good amount of time in the word and praying in the spirit. Feed your spirit so when you need to tap into spiritual things you have something in your spirit to tap into.
- ?? Meditate on the word you study. Speak it to yourself. Put it before your eyes. (I use 3x5 index cards and journals. I have healing journals with nothing but "medicinal" scriptures. I have scriptures dealing with financial wisdom and godly prosperity, etc.) Think about what you've read. Don't rush onto new things until you understand what you've already read.
- ?? Avoid listening to the world's opinion about weak areas in your life. "As a man thinketh in his heart, so is he." If you focus on sickness and disease you're going to have faith in its ability to hold you. You have gates in your body that allow things to reach your mind and heart; your eyes and your ears should be guarded.
- ?? Find two or three scriptures that hold the promises of God concerning your situation. Put them before you and present them to the Father during your prayer time.
- ?? Find a faithful and trust worthy prayer partner. No, not someone who uses prayer as a gossip session. If you know a person talks about others chances are good he/she will talk about you. Partners are good for the "prayer of agreement".
- ?? Keep a prayer journal with the need, the scriptures you're standing on, the date you prayed it and fi-

- nally a note with the date when it is manifested.
- ?? When you pray believe you receive the answer, not when you see it. Mark 11:22-26. Settle it in your heart when you pray that the answer is yours and then allow patience to work in your situation. After you settle the issue in your heart start thanking God for the answer. Don't speak the problem again.
 - ?? Always ask the Father in the name of Yeshua/Jesus. Yeshua told us to go to the Father in his stead. The Holy Spirit will confirm the word we're standing on with signs following!
 - ?? Pray out loud. You have the power of life and death in your tongue, not in your head. If you simply can't utter words then the Spirit will make intercession for you, but when it comes to things you can speak, speak them.
 - ?? Realize that you do have an enemy who doesn't want to see your prayers answered. You will face opposition, you will have to stand, but you can do it!
 - ?? Cooperate with your healing. Don't do things that make you sicker! If you feel worse after eating something, just quit it for a while. Don't rub lemon in an open wound.

tain into Carrizozo; NM got a fresh cup of coffee and headed north on highway 54. The farther north I got the colder it was getting, no not my coffee, the air outside! By the time I got to the intersection where 54 met 285 north it was snowing a little. By the time I got to Clines Corner the snow was coming down so hard they would not allow drivers to continue north on any highway. There I sat for at least two and possibly three hours watching the snow fall by the pound. I sat with six or seven truck drivers that began to gather when they over heard me talking to one person about the Lord and His salvation. All those wonderful men loved our Lord and served Him. It was clear they did so to the best of their ability in all given situations. They were a real encouragement to me at that time and they all told me that I had encouraged them by sharing the few things I spoke into their lives. I can't express my appreciation on paper to those of you that make what our Father asks me to do possible. I can say this however, truly for Taos you "sent to my need and it is not that I seek a gift, but fruit multiplying to your account". The things delivered from you to me abounded to more than enough, an odor of a sweet smell, an acceptable sacrifice, pleasing to our Father. And my Father will fill your every need according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus. Now may glory be to our God and Father to the ages of the ages. Amen. Greet every saint in Christ Jesus. come up with a time when she had acknowledged her need of a savior. Sure she'd asked for her personal sins to be forgiven, but had never asked for the sin she was to be forgiven and her life to be redeemed.

I don't want any person alive to be robbed of the knowledge that we are born in sin. That we were made sin by Adam's sin. We don't have to make a single mistake or sin a single sin, our behavior has nothing to do with the sin I'm talking about. Let me draw a picture. Let's consider the nuclear accident that happened in Chernobyl (this is where I'm headed in Russia). The pollution is invisible, but there nonetheless. That's sort of like the pollution of mankind that Adam brought on all mankind. He sinned and though we couldn't see it with natural eyes, we could most definitely feel its effects. Soon Adam's son Cain would kill his brother Abel. The pollution of sin had found its way into life blood of Adam's seed. Every seed that was born to Adam would be "polluted". No matter how "good" men tried to be their DNA was bad in some miniscule way.

Because of the work of Yeshua/Jesus we have been made the righteousness of God. *2 Cor 5:21 For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.* But it isn't automatic. You have to ask to be adopted into the kingdom of God. God is no bully and He is no "overlord". He is a Father. We were stolen from Him by hasatan.
