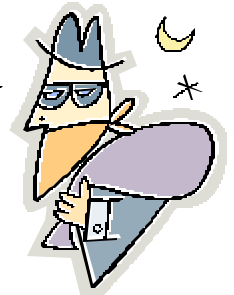

## Stealing the Rich Man's Harvest

As we move out amongst the people we are learning more and more about the Body of Christ, some of what we see is good and some of what we see is not so good. As an apostle's job is to bring the order of God back into the household of faith, so the work we do is one of restoration of God's order. Our focus is to do the will of God, which is the benefit of His sheep. One of the hardest things to see is the stingy nature that has infected the Body and as an antibiotic cleanses the natural body of infection so we spiritually want to cleanse the Body of Christ from this deadly infection.



Before we begin the application of the spiritual "antibiotic" let us consider the balances that must also be set before the people so they don't have to walk in fear. We've seen so much abuse of the sheep; all of us have seen it. That doesn't mean that we should simply throw up our hands and cry "woe is me". As those who are responsible for His sheep wherever we go, we want to see His sheep flourish and be productive. So we share this article with you all so that everyone can prosper according to God's word and plan.

We used to have a couple of actual sheep that lived across the fence from our yard. They were abused sheep. Their owner never sheered them, never did much of anything with or for them. They had huge cat's claws seeds (the sharpest ugliest thorns you've ever seen) wedged in their fur around their necks. They were abused, neglected and in sad shape. They were constantly hungry

and their bleating nearly ripped our hearts out. We began pulling the green weeds around our yard and feeding them. In the beginning we simply put the weeds and lawn clippings over the fence. Before too long they came to the fence when they saw us in the yard. Later on they would come to the fence and call us. Even later if they heard my voice they would come running. It was hard to see them suffer day after day, but we felt somewhat eased in that at least they weren't starving, but it simply wasn't enough. We ran out of weeds, the owner cleared his land of any green plant life and now the sheep are gone. We don't want to know what happened to them, as we came to really love those sheep.

We have all seen false shepherds or hirelings who only do the work of the ministry for money. You can see them coming a mile away. They surround themselves with stuff to excess, they don't shear the sheep but fleece them. (Sheering merely removes the excess wool, fleecing takes the hide and kills the sheep.) They don't associate with the poor or sickly sheep of God. They may even go after the substance of widows. We're all told "Love not the world, neither the things in the world". Why? Because God is going to purge this world by fire. If your heart is wrapped up in anything of this world you may end up being so offended at losing the stuff that you turn your back on God.

In the Body of Messiah (Christ) we see folks of all walks and with varying levels of wealth. We see "well to do folks" and we also see folks who live on around \$500 per month. That isn't much to live on if you know what it takes to live in this world these days.

When we first began this new walk we had no idea how finances worked for folks who are completely sustained by faith in God. We had heard lots of things about finances and both spent a great deal of time studying all the areas of the word in order to maintain a good balance. When we stepped out to do God's will by walking in the call and gift of the apostle we had "ideas" of how it would all work. Most of those ideas have changed. We learned that the same things that sustained us when we were working in the world sustained us as we endeavored to live more and more by faith in God. Tithing first, offerings second, alms for the poor being a huge sustaining thing, but the most important thing we learned was in Matthew 6:33. "Seek ye first the kingdom of God and His righteousness and all these things (the things that the lost seek after) will be added to you". As long as we kept our eyes off the money, off the stuff and straight ahead on God and His righteousness we would be just fine. We learned not to depend on the gifts of men and not to keep our eyes on any of it as our source. In fact we began purging our lives of much of the stuff we used to think we couldn't live without.

With all of this being said we also began seeing a pattern of stinginess in the oddest group within the Body, the wealthy. The ones who had the least as far as natural goods go gave the most and the ones who had the most gave the least. It was perplexing until we sought the Lord on the matter. He told us "The rich don't think they need a harvest". We were pretty taken back by it, but it sure made sense. *Prov 10:15 "The rich man's wealth is his strong city: the destruction of the poor is their poverty."* Men who depend on wealth create a strong city that is very hard to break into. The really sad thing is that these great people are often robbed of eternal riches because they learn to depend upon their finances in place of God. When they arrive in heaven, if they do indeed reach heaven, they have nothing to show for it. Many begin to depend upon their wealth to the exclusion of God.

Let's look at the story of the rich man and Lazarus. Luke 16:19-31 Lazarus was not only poor, but sick. He lived in a place where the people knew their responsibility to care for the poor and sick (in Israel), but he was forgotten and forsaken by men. He sat at the gate of a wealthy man. Every day the wealthy man saw the needs of this man and every day he simply hardened his heart and ignored him. Every day this wealthy man fared sumptuously the bible says. When they both finished their allotted time on earth they ended up in two opposite places once again, only this time Lazarus was comforted and the wealthy man tormented. His selfish attitude was still just as embedded in his heart as ever. He figured life would continue on as it had always, but he was very wrong. No longer would anyone feed him, cloth him, care for him or even consider him. He would suffer without for all of eternity. He asked for someone to return from the dead and warn his brothers. We would all think that would help, but to our surprise we learn that men who have this sort of infection are almost impossible to reach.

I know many wealthy people who claim to be believers, but they really love their wealth and love their stuff. They collect all sorts of stuff, way more than they can ever use in a life time and just sit on it like a dog on a bone. They dole out tiny amounts of stuff when their consciences squeak, but on the whole they are misers and hoarders. In the end it doesn't hurt the ones they are stingy towards, but devastates the selfish.

So why do we share these words when most of the folks we reach are not wealthy? Let's look at Deuteronomy 8 and learn why even the poorest of poor should be aware of this story. You really need to read this whole chapter. It's your whole life's story. You start out as a believer, like Y'shua you go through a time of hunger and what looks like lack. You will go through the wilderness and will be tempted by the adversary. Next you are taken to the first Promised Land and the Lord begins to entrust you with wealth. He tells you to be on the look out for pride. When pride comes in and you forget the Father and what He has done you can get in real big trouble.

None of us wants to end up in heaven without a harvest. We all have the potential to become wealthy when we obey the word of God. We also have the potential to fall for the stuff. If you already have wealth, you need to really guard your hearts so you can be like Joseph of Arimathaea (Matt. 27:57). He was a rich man, but he was also a disciple of Y'shua/Jesus. He clearly had passed the mammon test and knew he couldn't get his eyes on the material stuff. He gave up his own tomb (a very expensive gift) for his Lord. He had to have been a tither, he had to have been a generous giver, he had to have been involved in promoting the gospel and he had to keep the money at arm's reach.

What's at stake? Y'shua warned again when he shared the parable of the sower. The deceitfulness of riches has the potential power (if not recognized and dealt with) to steal the seed (Y'shua) right out of our hearts. Let's not allow the adversary to trick us into being selfish, greedy or stingy. Give and give generously wherever the Lord directs. Be a cheerful sower. Look for poor folks to bless. Purge your stuff on a regular basis. Give the best so you can reap the best. Keep your eyes on God at all cost. Seek Him, seek His kingdom, seek after righteousness (right standing) and keep on the lookout for the nasty spirit of pride. You aren't a "self made man" and your own strength didn't get you one single thing. Don't let the devil get your harvest.

## Working Out With Jeff

### THE FOURTH TEMPLE

There has been much talk about what people in certain circles are calling the "third temple". From the beginning I would like to bring believer's attention to the fact that the reference to the construction of a third temple is an obvious ploy of the evil one to deceive any who would buy the lie that believers should support and participate in such an endeavor.

### READ YOUR BIBLE!!!

I am going to take you back in history for your edification, which is after all what brotherhood in the body of Christ is all about. In the year 2928 or 833BC the building of the first temple began and was directed by Solomon, King David's son. His father David left him all the directions of just how the first temple should be built, please remember that. This first temple stood for 410 years and was burnt to the ground by one of Nebuchadnezzar's henchmen by the name of Nebuzradan. Nebuzradan and his men laid siege on Jerusalem on the 7<sup>th</sup> of Av setting it ablaze on the 9<sup>th</sup> of Av and it burned for 24 hours.

In 3390 or 371BC King Darius was killed after ruling as king for only one year. Cyrus became king and ruled from Persia and almost immediately began encouraging the Jewish people of Babylon to "rebuild" the temple. Today this of course has become known as the second temple. Our heavenly Father only knows how many Israelites were in Babylon when this occurred, but it is a matter of history that only about 40,000 people, maybe a few more, returned to Jerusalem with Zerubabel. In 3391 or 370BC Zerubabel built an altar, doing so without any stones of the temple's foundation laid and the beginning of the "rebuilding" of what has always been referred to as the second temple. This second temple only stood for approximately 439 years. In 3830 or 70 AD on the 7<sup>th</sup> of Av Titus laid siege to Jerusalem and its second temple. The Babylonians destroyed the first temple. The Romans destroyed

the second temple. Everything about these two events was identical; the time of its siege being the 7<sup>th</sup> of Av, the time of its destruction was the 9<sup>th</sup> of Av. The only difference was the nationality of the armies.

Now, today as I write this, we are hearing about those who would like to “rebuild” the temple now calling it the third temple. Please understand I know that scripture demands that a temple be built one more time but nowhere in our bibles does it refer to it as the third temple. There must be a temple built for the prophetic scriptures concerning the anti-christ to come to pass. I don’t want to digress into something we all should have learned in our first year of New Testament bible study. Just know that there will be an anti-christ person who needs a temple in Jerusalem to stand in and call himself god. Many will believe what he says and follow him for whatever reason, (mostly because they aren’t born-again). But today on this earth right now there is rampant deception on such a grand scale one can only intercede for those who the Spirit of God leads. Someone telling you about this future building in Jerusalem, and referring to as the third temple, is just as false as if they also told you that Goliath won the battle against David.

The building of the third temple began in approximately 3790 or year 30 which was the year Yeshua was offered, crucified and resurrected. The building of the body of Christ was underway at that time. He told His disciples that the gates of hell would not prevail against His body being made up of people that received Him as the final sacrifice for sin. There would be no more shedding of blood from bulls and goats in this third temple because His blood was the final, pure and acceptable blood offered for up you and me. This third temple will not fall on a 9<sup>th</sup> of Av like the two previous temples before it. No fire will burn this third temple to the ground as it is an everlasting building with God our Father as the one who upholds it with His powerful word. This temple, the body of Christ, is an everlasting temple not made with hands. It is molded by the Holy Spirit who is sent to accomplish this task in the hearts of men. To all that receive Him He will give power to become the sons of God.

That leaves us with something that needs a bit of clarification. As you have read in your own bibles and as I have already mentioned, there will be a building in Jerusalem that the anti-christ will stand in and there declare himself to be god. This must happen. *This* should be referred to as the fourth temple. This fourth temple will once again in my understanding, be completely destroyed by fire on the 9<sup>th</sup> of Av. If you study at all in history books and the bible you should know why the enemy destroyed the first and second temples. God’s people rejected His word for them and went about establishing their own righteousness worshipping the creation more than the creator. Solomon had a concept about life on this planet, he said in Ecclesiastes 1:9 “The thing that has been, it is that which shall be; and that which is done is that which shall be done: and there is no new thing under the sun.” In today’s vernacular he said, “History always repeats itself.” Are you born-again? Is everyone in your own personal sphere of influence aware that you are a child of the Most High God? Have they heard from you the ONLY way to get to the Father is through the Son? We, the body of Christ, have been given a tremendous honor in the fact that we can do greater works than even Yeshua did...we can lead someone to Him as He builds His third and the ONLY “eternal” temple!!

## Atmospheric Disturbances

*God*". So here we are and we know we need faith, we have to have faith and yet it seems like our faith is just plain not working. So why isn't it working? I'll tell you why; it is because we are living in an atmosphere of unbelief and doubt. Unbelief and doubt are spiritual upper level disturbing forces. This all sounds pretty ominous, but if you realize that Y'shua (Jesus) had the same problem when he was here we can find a solution to the problem.

Matt 13:58 And he did not many mighty works there because of their *unbelief*.

Mark 6:4-6 But Jesus said unto them, a prophet is not without honor, but in his own country, and among his own kin, and in his own house. And he could there do no mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed them. And he marveled because of their *unbelief*.

Mark 16:14 Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their *unbelief* and *hardness of heart*, because they *believed not* them which had seen him after he was risen.

Unbelief and doubt cause our hearts to be hardened and when they are hardened the seeds of faith can't sprout. No amount of watering can get to seeds in hard packed soil. If it does reach the seed it will drown it. Y'shua was sent from heaven. He had the authority of heaven behind him and yet he was limited when unbelief and doubt were present. So what did he do when these two evil twins were present? He sent out the unbelievers. Let's look at an excellent example of just such a case.

Luke 8:50-56 *"But when Jesus heard it, he answered him, saying, Fear not: **believe only**, and she shall be made whole. And when he came into the house, he suffered no man to go in, save Peter, and James, and John, and the father and the mother of the maiden. And all wept, and bewailed her: but he said, Weep not; she is not dead, but sleepeth. And they laughed him to scorn, **knowing** that she was dead. And he put them all out, and took her by the hand, and called, saying, Maid, arise. And her spirit came again, and she arose straightway: and he commanded to give her meat. And her parents were astonished: but he charged them that they should tell no man what was done"*.

Here we have Y'shua entering into Jairus' home. Y'shua removes the mourners because they are full of doubt and unbelief. Clearly this situation would have been hindered by the unbelief and doubt of the people. Only after removing the doubters was he able to raise her from the dead.

In my personal life I am dealing with recognizing and dealing with doubt and unbelief. It isn't an easy thing to do, but I want to have my faith be fruitful. First I have asked the Holy Spirit to signal me when I'm hearing thoughts of doubt or unbelief. When a thought like "You're not going to be able to pay your bills" or "God isn't going to heal you this time" I have asked the Holy Spirit to intervene and "raise a red flag" in my face. I then follow the instructions of 2 Corinthians 10:4-5. I cast down these vain imaginations and every high thing which exalts itself above the knowledge of God. I bring those thoughts captive to the obedience of Christ.

It's always surprising to me how sneaky the adversary is. He slithers and skulks into my thoughts and harasses me until I fatigue. Then he suggests a multitude of things until I swallow one of his hooks. My great lovely heavenly Father is so much stronger than that fallen angel old satan, that He has already created my salvation from the deception of the adversary before the foundation of time. Abba is so far ahead of satan that He created a way of escape before the adversary had even made his first move. Hasatan was defeated before he threw his first punch.

You live surrounded by unbelievers who spout unbelief on a daily basis. The television is like a filthy fountain of unbelief. Your radio and newspapers are also full of doubt and unbelief. People

that are around you are also full to the brim with unbelief. So what are you to do? Turn the TV off. Turn the radio off. Put down your papers and magazines. Fast these things for a month. Now while you are purging yourself of the unbelief take time to get in the word. Read it, speak it to yourself, pray in the spirit and then worship God with song and with confession of His Holy word. Do it for a full month. Now see if you don't feel better. See if your prayers don't become effective and you see the manifestation in a shorter time.

There isn't much one can do about natural upper level disturbances, but you certainly don't stand outside in the rain during a storm. So why would you stand out in a spiritual storm? Go into the secret place. When unbelief comes to harass you address it like you would address the adversary. The word tells us "Submit to God, resist the devil and he will flee". The devil is the author of unbelief and doubt and you should resist his fruit just like you resist him. His fruit is rotten. His fruit has nasty thorns. His fruit has wicked seed.

## Miraculous Answer

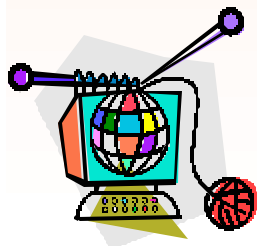
Ps 105:19 Until the time that his word came: the word of the LORD tried him.
