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The Right Side of the Fence

Last month we shared about the “Atmospheric Disturbances” of doubt and unbelief. This month we want to go more in depth into how to deal with them. To leave you hanging with the knowledge of the fact we are surrounded by these two things without answers would be a cruel joke, so let’s look a little closer at each and then find the answers to them in the word.

First let’s look at the word “doubt”. If we look it up in the Strong’s Concordance we learn that it can mean a couple of things.

NT:1365

distazo (dis -tad’-zo); from NT:1364; properly, *to duplicate*, i.e. (ment.) *to waver (in opinion)*:

KJV - doubt.

NT:1252

diakrino (dee-ak-ree’-no); from NT:1223 and NT:2919; to separate thoroughly, i.e. (literally and reflexively) to withdraw from, or (by implication) oppose; figuratively, to discriminate (by implication, decide), or (reflexively) *hesitate*:

KJV - contend, make (to) differ (-ence), discern, doubt, judge, be partial, *stagger*, *waver*

You will notice that the thing that stands out most about doubting is a wavering that comes from halting between two opinions. An easier way to understand this sort of staggering or wavering is to be of “two minds”. James makes is pretty clear that being double minded makes us unable to receive anything from God. *James 1:6-8 “But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord. A double minded man is unstable in all his ways”.*

Let us imagine we are in a place where we need something from God. We find a scripture that promises what we’re asking for. We decide to claim the promise and then to stand. Immediately doubt enters onto the scene and we are tempted to believe the natural facts over the spiritual truth we have found in the word. We have two pictures going on in our minds. We have a temporary negative situation and we have an eternal truth. The adversary will rehearse the “facts” to us until he either convinces us we are “stuck” with the facts or until he is defeated by our stand of faith. So how do we make this successful stand of faith? First we have to recognize the “facts” as temporary. Even terminal illness is only temporary at best. If we die of a disease it can only affect us on earth, it can’t reach into heaven. The worst financial situation too is only temporary. If we lose everything we have that’s as bad as it gets and is temporary. We die and end up in heaven inheriting the gold of eternal streets and the mansions that Y’shua/Jesus has prepared for us. So the worst “facts” are always temporary. When God speaks a truth into being it is the same yesterday, today and forever.

Once we decide that God’s word is bedrock that we can depend upon, we have to make the decision to stand on that bedrock until we win. The adversary can only beat us if we quit prematurely. *Gal 6:9 “And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not”.* It’s about staying our course until we reap, because fainting can not be an option.

Ok, so we make the decision that God's word is our foundation. It's eternal and unbending and we can depend upon it. Then we make the decision to stand until we win. Next we have to deal with the "vain imaginations" the adversary sends. He loves to paint ugly scenarios and he has what I call a "flip chart" of lies he tries on believers. He may start with cancer but if he can't get you to believe that, he'll try a cold. We have to deal with every single thought and idea that doesn't line up with the word. *2 Cor 10:4-5 "For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds. Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;"*

After Jeff was electrocuted he had to deal with the horrible affects of his body being exposed to nearly 20,000 volts of electricity. His one side was completely cooked and he needed healing and restoration. The Lord gave him instructions to go to the word everyday and get "manna" for this restoration. He told me that in the beginning he did more "casting down vain imaginations" than anything else. Having worked in the power line industry for many years, he had a vast knowledge of what electricity would do to the human body. These "facts" would come and haunt him and he had to decide that what God had said in His word was eternal and more dependable than the words of the best experts in this natural world. He even fought hallucinations for about six months because his brain had been cooked too. The more word he put in himself, the more of his flesh the Lord could touch and restore.

It matters little what your situation is if you will turn your face toward God and His will (His word is His will). The more of the word you submit your mind and flesh to, the more of God's grace will manifest in your life.

Let's begin by meditating upon these following scriptures. Before we do, let's consider that they are written by James (actually Yacov) the brother of Y'shua/Jesus. He walked with the Lord long enough to really have this lesson engrained in his life. *James 4:6-8 "But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble. Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and **purify your hearts, ye double minded**".* We want to purify our minds by keeping them clear of anything that runs contrary to the word of God. We want our minds full of nothing but the unadulterated pure word of God. This means we cast out the junk until we have nothing but the promise we're standing on. It takes work, it takes diligence and it takes bull dogged tenacity, but the end result is we get the promise we believe for.

Heb 11:6 "But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him".

Angelic Intervention

Here's another faith builder for those of you who love testimonies to God's faithfulness. We trust that these words will uplift and encourage you.

We have only been back a couple of days from our February trip to New Mexico. While there we made our "normal" stop in Ruidoso. We took our 34' travel trailer "Shaynee" and our Suburban. The weather in Ruidoso was supposed to be snowy, but it had only just begun so we felt safe in making the journey. Jeff called ahead to a brother in Ruidoso and was told to leave our RV at his mother-in-law's home. We then headed up the mountain to his home. cliff and all the way to the bottom. I asked the angels to help him get down, but I began to wonder what my next course of action should be. I couldn't see Jeff, I couldn't see the Suburban and the dog was beginning to shiver. I just prayed in the spirit. It seemed like an eternity and all I could hear was the wind whipping through the trees. The snow was blowing like ice into my face and I thought about walking down the mountain to find Jeff. Just about that time I saw Jeff walking up the mountain my direction. He walked Chorney and I back to the Suburban, which he had parked next to a cell site. Once back in the car he related the miracle that had happened once I got out of the car.

He told me that he did indeed begin to slip uncontrollably down the mountain, but just before he was about to hit the short post and chain fence (the only thing between him and a long drop off the mountain) he looked in his rear view mirror and his elbow knocked the gear shift into drive. This "accidental" action helped him maneuver all the way down to where the car presently rested. He would have never have thought to put the car in drive to go backwards, but it had saved the car and his life. We both knew an angel had caused his arm to slip and hit the gear shift.

Prayer does work! Fear is an enemy and to be resisted no matter what the situation. We're so glad we have praying brothers and sisters all over Texas and New Mexico. We're also glad we have angels assigned to watch over us. Angelic Master Guards; don't leave home without them.

The Tongue Talking Pharisee

There is a move of the adversary to take hold of all the new found knowledge of Hebrew roots and cause the Body of Christ to either dump the New Testament or dump the "Old" Testament. It's not a big deal because hasatan has always tried to take the truth and twist it to corrupt something good that God is doing. But with all that having been said we don't want to "dump out the baby with the bath water". If we consider the story of Y'shua at the well with the Samaritan woman we can see that there was more to the faith of our Lord than just Orthodox Judaism. An Orthodox Jew would never have sat with a Samaritan woman. Many would have us believe that Y'shua was a practicing Orthodox Jew and he was not. That may crater many folks, but in all truth he wasn't a Jew he was Hebrew. Orthodox Judaism is a relatively new thing; in fact the word Judaism didn't even exist when Y'shua was alive. The letter J didn't even exist up until about 500 years ago. So why are we seeing all this confusion? It is because folks have forgotten that the first "church" (actually it

was the first believing called out congregation) was full of spirit-filled, tongue talking, Torah loving Hebrew people. In fact most of the New Testament, as we call it today, was written by a spirit-filled, tongue talking, Torah loving Pharisee. This man we call Paul, his actual name was Shaul, was raised knowing all the "traditions of the elders" and all the religious practices of the Hebrew people of his day. Strangely enough he called all the religious things he knew dung in comparison to Y'shua and gaining the anointing (Christ) that destroyed the yoke of bondage in his life. Phil. 4:3-8

This man Paul, and yes he was just a man, had lived as zealous for the commandments as any man alive. He called himself a "Pharisee of Pharisees". He was responsible for chasing down believers in Y'shua and seeing to their destruction and their death. Our very Lord stepped down off his throne in glory to arrest Paul's attack on the Body. He took it very personally in that he said to Paul "Why persecutest thou **me**?" Acts 26:14.

Paul had a really hard road ahead of himself, one that would become his very own cross. The really awesome thing is that after he had been touched by the Lord on the road to Damascus, he willingly chose to climb up on his cross and die to all the things he held so near and dear. As devoted and as zealous as he had been for the "traditions of the elders", he was for the cause of the yoke destroying anointing of the Holy Spirit.

I've heard men claim that the Jews should not be evangelized. That they have a covenant with God and don't need to believe that Y'shua was, is and shall ever be Messiah. I say "hog wash". Just last week while watching a program by born again Jews I heard a rabbi say these words. "There is nothing more anti-Semitic than not to preach salvation to a Jew". This man had been an Orthodox Jew and had come to be born again after receiving the knowledge that Y'shua was his Messiah. He clearly knew there was a difference between before his salvation and after. Does that mean he should stop being a Jew? God forbid. How can you know the right way of doing things and then stop doing it? The main difference is that now he has the power to be a son of God. He has the anointing (empowerment) to live eternally. Does that mean that those of us not raised

in Judaism should become Jews in order to have a more perfect walk? God forbid that as well. Surely we want to purge any godlessness or any pagan roots we may have, but we're told that unless we do everything prescribed by the law we are under a curse. Gal 3:10 "*For as many as are of the works of the law are **under the curse**: for it is written, Cursed is every one that continueth not in **all things which are written in the book of the law to do them**".* KJV Does that mean we should do whatever we want? Again, God forbid. Our job is to hear the Holy Spirit and do whatever he says. We are all about hearing *the voice* of God for ourselves. How do we hear **His voice**? By faith. We're told the just shall live by faith. Today we are supposed to hear **THE VOICE, the voice** of the Holy Spirit by faith. How do we get faith? Rom 10:17 "*So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God*". Let us take just a little time and examine this scripture.

Faith is the substance of things that we are hoping for, right? Yes. Faith is also the evidence of things that we can not see, right? Again the answer is yes. We are hoping for heaven and the kingdom of God. This is something we can't see with our natural eyes so it requires faith. Even our Jewish brothers want to see heaven and the kingdom of God. They aren't doing all this legalistic work just to be better than anyone else. Their goal is our goal. Problem is there is only one way to heaven and that's through God's prescribed door. His door is Y'shua/Jesus. The Jews ignorantly believe that the only kingdom there is will be in Jerusalem on the temple mount. True there will be a natural temple on the mount in Jerusalem. BUT and I say this loudly, BUT there is also a spiritual temple (ALL WHO BELIEVE IN Y'SHUA, BOTH JEW AND GENTILE ARE THAT TEMPLE). Until Y'shua returns, we the spiritual temple rule and reign on earth. We're here to destroy the works of the adversary and put him under Y'shua's feet. The fruit of his works are everywhere, but his tree is invisible. It is the tree of knowledge of **good** and **evil**. Now back to faith and hearing **THE VOICE**. (Take just a few hours and look up everywhere in the bible where you find the words his voice, or the voice. You'll be amazed at how many times you can find them. You can find "the voice of the Lord" 50 times in the Old Testament alone.)

Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God. We need faith, we need for it to come, we need to walk by faith, and we need to live by faith. In order to have faith we need to hear which requires hearing ears. We need not only to hear, but to keep on hearing. The ending <ing> speaks of a continuing action. Add <ing> to any verb and it speaks of a continuing process. The Pharisee Shaul didn't hear God's voice before Y'shua stopped him on the road to Damascus. He had the knowledge of what was good and what was evil. He lived by that knowledge and it kept him alive. If he followed the good he lived, if he followed the evil he died. He did everything he possibly could to be as good as he possibly could. Clearly he couldn't maintain that perfect walk as he had to take sin sacrifices to the physical temple in Jerusalem. Even with all those sacrifices he was dead spiritually. Every year his high priest (whoever it was at the time of Shaul's life) would offer sin sacrifice for the people on Yom Kippur. Every year Shaul would clean out "chametz" before Pesach (Passover). Every year he would make a pilgrimage to Jerusalem for the three prescribed festivals. This process continued all of his life. With all of this God prescribed activity he was still dead spiritually. Sure he was alive walking on the planet, but he had no spiritual contact with Abba Father. In fact he couldn't even call God his Father, he called Abraham his father. But all of this ends in the best of news. Y'shua stopped Shaul on that road to Damascus and gave him instructions on what to do. For the first time in his life Paul heard **THE VOICE** of God. Y'shua never spoke anything but what the Father told him to speak. The Father must have instructed Y'shua to step down and arrest Shaul's wrongful zeal. Y'shua was the word of God in the flesh. So when Shaul heard Y'shua he heard the voice of God. He heard and faith came. Next he continued hearing because he DID what Y'shua told him to. Not long after that Ananias came to him and ministered healing for his eyes and salvation for his spirit. From that day on Shaul strived to hear "**THE VOICE**" and obey. He didn't stop going to the synagogue (until it became impossible for him to do so), he didn't stop going to the temple and he didn't stop being a Torah loving Hebrew man. He did however, quit following the oral commandments handed down from father to son for all the generations before him. He now listened for the oral commandments of God via "**THE VOICE**". He prayed in the spirit (in tongues) Isaiah 28:11 and was taught by God rather than going to the scribes and Pharisees he had known all his life. He got all his instructions from God. He didn't always follow what he heard, but he did his best.

The Father gave me this illustration a while ago, but I'll never stop using it. If you had your choice of reading the love letters from your most beloved family member who had gone onto heaven or having that person show up at your door which would you choose? Most would choose the real person. Sure we all keep the love letters to remind us of those sweet times, but the real person is far greater. Today some are locking the door to God in favor of old letters. They don't want to hear **THE VOICE**. It's hard to imagine, but that's how deception works.

We need the love letters before us to remind us what the Father has spoken to us. It helps us identify whether we're hearing **THE VOICE** of God or the great imitator. We study the love letters so we'll always recognize it when **THE VOICE** speaks.

What If They're Wrong?

We're hearing a lot of folks falling for one of the worst deceptions ever and it's based on the kind of love that kills. Have you ever seen a parent that thinks that a parent that loves never says no to his/her child? Have you ever seen a parent who refused to discipline his/her child? Have you ever seen the result of this kind of love? The child is unruly and eventually becomes a living breathing monster. When the child grows up he/she believes that there are absolutely no consequences to behavior, all he/she knows how to do is manipulate and cajole to get what he/she wants. They become totally self-absorbed and honestly believe that everyone is here to meet his/her needs. This is what we call misappropriated love and it's a real killer. Sure it's hard to watch your child make mistakes and pay small consequences to bad behavior, but it's far better to pay a small consequence and learn that there are consequences than to get out in the world and end up in jail or worse.

Now back to the deception that is creeping into the body of Messiah. The lie is that not everyone needs Y'shua/Jesus as Lord. I know we've shared this before, but it just isn't going away and we hear folks who should be grounded in the word sharing how they think the Jews don't need Y'shua as their Messiah. The teachers of this lie are just as deceived as those they teach it to.

We won't go into all the scripture that proves it because it seems that folks who hear it have pretty much dismissed the New Testament as a source for God's will. We will just leave you all with one thought. OK, so let's pretend they don't need Y'shua everything will be ok. Now let's imagine it's not true and they do need Y'shua. Imagine you're that Jewish person and everyone around you is being taught that you don't need Y'shua the Messiah who has already come. Believers pass you everyday and know you're a Jew but never want to hurt your feelings or make you feel bad about your situation. They are totally eased into thinking you're safe and "All Israel will be saved". This is true but is being taught out of context and not weighed against all the other scripture. You reach the age when you're about to die and still you hear nothing. You keep doing all the religious things you've been taught since childhood and you die. They bury you in the traditional way and there are lots of mourners. Everyone eats and the mirrors are all covered for the prescribed time period. Folks back on earth are back to the normalcy of life, but what about you?

The Temple of God

It's the last day of February and hearing the voice of God for you and for what to share with you is our goal. Whether we rise early to hear, stay up late, fast or pray for you as the Body of Messiah we do it for your benefit and finishing of God's will on the earth. Why is this? Because God created a plan before we ever existed to deal with evil when it would show up and ultimately destroy it using us His children.

1 John 3:8

*...The devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the **Son of God** was manifested, that he might **destroy the works of the devil**.*

There are lots of people who would back off from this, but as the Body of Christ, the Anointed Messiah we have to push on through the hardness of this truth. We are actually the body of the Son of God. We have been called with a holy calling. We are **all** called to carry out the work, which Y'shua began 2000 years ago. He left us with a commission (Mark 16:15-20) and we must carry it out. Before we can do the job in its perfection we must come in the unity of our faith. This includes both the saints (Hebrew believers in Y'shua) and those of use who **used to be** aliens and strangers to the covenant of faith (now called faithful brethren in Y'shua).

*Eph 4:11-13 And he gave some, **apostles**; and some, **prophets**; and some, **evangelists**; and some, **pastors and teachers**; For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ: **Till we all come in the unity of the faith**, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:*

God's plan is much like the plan of a master contractor or builder. He had a plan to have a huge kingdom with children of all sorts. He first had a "dream" or vision of this plan and then He "sketched" it out and then began sharing it by speaking it. His plan involved others, He used messengers (angels) and He needed craftsmen. First He created a master plan for all the workers to go by. He called it "Torah" or Instructions in our English vernacular. His ultimate plan was for this "Torah" to be fleshed out. His ultimate plan was for His word to become flesh so that He could love and live within it. He wanted a permanent dwelling place within His creation.

Much like the enemies of Nehemiah when he rebuilt the walls of Jerusalem, the enemy claims he too wants to help rebuild, but remember he's a liar. He's been semi successful at it in the past, but again Abba Father has outsmarted this low level destroyer.

Today we have access to the Instructions and it has free course in our lives. We're obeying and submitting to more and more of the Master Builder's plans. We've begun to see the "bones" of it as the work goes on. Not only do we see the bones, but when the Master Builder comes to inspect our work we get down right excited. He is manifesting Himself more and more as the body of it comes into manifestation. We love being a part of it all and we are learning to work together as a team to see to it that His plans are carried out perfectly.
