



Funeral Dirge for the Devil!



We're surrounded with all sorts of bad news, wars, and rumors of wars, plagues, pestilence, poverty and destitution. If we allowed ourselves to focus on these

we'd all dig a hole and climb into it. Y'shua told us these things were coming and he also told us to see to it that our hearts weren't troubled because of these things. Why are they coming? These hard things are coming because we have an adversary, the devil, who wants to stop God in His tracks. Satan's time on earth is limited and he knows it. Can he stop God's plan? No way. Will he give up? I don't think so. So what do we do with the bad news? What did the two spies do with all the bad reports? They refused them. Caleb and Joshua said "we are well able to possess the land". The ten with the bad report weren't allowed in to the Promised Land. Their faith was in their own ability to do something and not in God's ability or desire to save His people.

Here we are in the world, but as the word says, "not of this world". We have a job to do and it's to destroy the works of the adversary. Our focus has to be on the job ahead of us. It will require us to understand things spiritually, not religiously. Our work as sons of God is to live the life that Y'shua lived. All of these awful things that are happening are really distractions. It's like the adversary hears his funeral dirge playing in the background and he's trying to make us believe he isn't dead. He's making all sorts of racket and jumping up in front of us as if to say, "I'm alive and well". Guess what? He's been dying since the first time iniquity was found in him. He is trying to get us to be-

lieve he's way more powerful than our Father and that the work of Y'shua/Jesus was ineffective. Wrong! Let me share with you a funeral dirge that Father God wrote back in the times of Ezekiel. He told us as the son of man to speak it to him. The Father spoke the devil's end in the Garden of God and today we are that Garden.

In preparation for your understanding, let me share that the word "lamentation" in Hebrew (quinaw) means funeral dirge. A funeral dirge is the song played during a funeral. This dirge is to be played along with drums or the beating of the chest. Let's all speak this funeral dirge and remind the devil that he's nothing more than so much dust under our feet. Also, the reference here is to the "king of Tyrus". As you read this passage you will discover that this "king" was in the "garden of God, Eden". No earthly king was ever in the Garden of Eden.

Ezek 28:12-19

12 Son of man, take up a lamentation upon the king of Tyrus, and say unto him, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Thou sealest up the sum, full of wisdom, and perfect in beauty.

13 Thou hast been in Eden the garden of God; every precious stone was thy covering, the sardius, topaz, and the diamond, the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper, the sapphire, the emerald, and the carbuncle, and gold: the workmanship of thy tabrets and of thy pipes was prepared in thee in the day that thou wast created.

14 Thou art the anointed cherub that covereth; and I have set thee so: thou wast upon the holy mountain of God; thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire.

15 Thou wast perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till iniquity was found in thee.

16 By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence, and thou hast sinned: therefore I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire.

17 Thine heart was lifted up because of thy beauty; thou hast corrupted thy wisdom by reason of thy brightness: I will cast thee to the ground; I will lay thee before kings, that they may behold thee.

Putting the Foundation Back Under the Household of Faith

SHAVUOT/PENTECOST



Three months after the children of Israel were delivered from Egypt they came to the Sinai desert and camped at or before Mt. Sinai. It wasn't until all Israel had pitched their tents at the mountain that Moses went up unto God. After Moses went up unto God did God speak to him out of the mountain and said: "Tell the house of Jacob...", "You saw what I did to the Egyptians and how I delivered you to Me, NOW if you will obey my Voice and keep My covenant, THEN you shall be a peculiar treasure unto Me...and you shall be a kingdom of priests and a holy nation..." (Exodus 19:1-6) In verse 8 all the people answered together saying, "All that The Lord has spoken we will do". They all said this before God said anything directly to them. We need to see that everything God has done, is doing and will do in the future has an order and plan that is unchangeable. Anything we see happening in the world today, it has been before. (Eccl 1: 9)

With that in mind let's look at something very key to us as Spirit-filled believers in The Messiah that came in the flesh and was crucified. I believe it will empower you to preach the Gos-

pel to others. Moses was directed by God Himself to go to all the people and tell them to get ready today and tomorrow. Two days were given to all the people to get ready for His coming down on the Mt. on the third day. Jesus told all the people that He had much He wanted to tell them but they could not bear it until The Holy Spirit came into the earth. For then all people would be able to understand the words He spoke. (Matt 16: 12-13) All the people at the foot of the mountain in Exodus 19. had two days to get ready for The Lord to come down to them. Peter told us that 1 day is as 1000 years with The Lord and 1000 years is as 1 day. (2nd Pet.3: 8-9) Do you see it? 2 days all the people in the desert were given to get ready, because of what Jesus accomplished through the first two festivals, Sukkoth and Passover the whole world now has been given two days or 2000 years to get ready for His coming down on the Mt. again! At the end of the 2000 years or 2 days The Messiah Himself will descend with a blast of the shofar and a shout and the Third day will begin! The millennial reign of another 1000-year period or one day!

The Holy Spirit was left here on earth by God and given to the entire world 2000 years ago. Why? So everyone could get ready for His coming down on the Mount the 3rd day. Come on if you're not shouting right about now with tears and laughter you need this Holy Spirit I am telling you about. You cannot receive Him unless you have fulfilled **Sukkoth/Tabernacles** in your life, meaning you understand that your flesh body is your temporary dwelling place. Your mother gave birth to that but you need to be born twice or born again because that flesh body cannot see God or His Kingdom. (John 3) You must be born again ALL PEOPLE of the world must be born again. When you receive the blood of "The Final Sacrifice" and rub it all over the doorpost of that temporary dwelling you have fulfilled **Pesach/Passover** in your life as well! You have been born again by faith in that blood being enough so that the death angel has "PASSED OVER" you! Now we are looking into the first **Shavuot/Pentecost** and that is the day God desired to reveal **His Word** to all the people individually but didn't get to. So He gave the written Word to them. By the will of all the people He gave command to one man to write it down. (Ex 24:4) "And Moses wrote all the words of the LORD". Because of their disobedience The Holy Spirit was not given at that time to all the people to enable them to receive revelation of His Word. At that time they were not made into a kingdom of priests. So by the order and rule that God Himself set into place all the people were given 2 days or 2000 years to get ready again. 2000 years to realize they could not "do" the written word to please God. 2000 years went by between the day that Moses wrote all that God said and the day that Jesus came into the earth, and they still weren't ready when He came. They did not recognize Him. Now we begin to understand what Jesus said, "When The Holy Spirit is come He will reveal all things to you whatsoever I have said unto you". The people could not understand the words Moses wrote down simply because they refused God's first offer. "Obey My voice and I will make you a nation of priests". But because they refused to "hear" His

voice He gave them another 2 days or 2000 years to get ready and they were not ready even then. Jesus said they could not understand what He spoke to them as well. But when The Holy Spirit was given to the whole world to be able to receive revelation of ALL The Word it was then that they could be born again, because their eyes were opened by The Holy Spirit and 3000 Israelites received Jesus as Messiah on the temple mount when Peter preached that Jesus was Messiah. (Acts 2: 38-41) By the way it was Pentecost when Peter was saying all this to ALL the people from the mount. (Acts 2:1) 5000 more Israelites were born again a very short time later (Acts 4: 4) and more and more were added to the church daily such as were saved. (Acts 2: 47) Then apostles were chosen and sent to the non-Israelite so they as well could be born again into a kingdom of priests because there is neither Israelite nor Non-Israelite in The Messiah. The playing field is level with only two types of people on it...lost people and saved people. God's plan and order is coming into view for ALL people to "see". For God so loved THE WORLD He gave His Only Begotten Son and because of what He FINISHED The Holy Spirit could be left here on earth, SHA-VUOT/PENTECOST, so ALL people can receive revelation by That Spirit that The Messiah has come in the flesh and become that kingdom of priests that God wanted in His first order and plan. Blessed or Cursed?



The life of the believer should be one of blessing. Our heavenly Father told us that we could chose between a life of life and blessing or death and cursing. Life and blessing would be my obvious choice, but not everyone sees it that way. Ps 35:27

Ok so we can see that God wants us to prosper, how do we walk in that prosperity? Easy, obedience. The more of the word we walk in, the more blessings come our way. 3 John 2-3

Josh 1:8



Working Out With Jeff



Mark 7:13 Jesus said some were, "Making the word of God of none effect through your tradition..."

Getting believers to make traditions is the devil's most successful tactic, but because of

The Holy Spirit we believers don't have to continue in traditions we may have learned or even started ourselves. We were created out of dirt and God gave dominion, to enable us to "tend the garden" so to speak. This dirt, i.e. us, is hard and crusted over before we are empowered or filled or anointed by God's Spirit. We are the ones that must break up the fallow ground and there is a great tool given to **ALL** mankind to enable him to do just that, repentance! Repentance is the plow that makes ready the dirt for the seed to be planted, it takes root in good soil and sprouts producing 30-60-&100 fold returns. It is the goodness of God that draws **ALL** men to repentance, so when He plants His seed (The Word) in our heart, it will accomplish what He sent it to do! And because of that we become sowers as well. Some sow good seed and some sow bad, but all sow!

All believers need to be encouraged! We have something the devil wants! We have something that gives us the ability to do things we don't naturally have the ability to do! How many of you consider yourselves "word" people? How many of you might have traditions that make the Word of God of no effect? OK, Then we must understand this first thing! God has order and repentance is the first thing in that order. The Word of God should have effect in our lives first. If it doesn't we cannot have an effect in the lives of others.

Let's take a look at just one tradition that has crept into this world. It goes like this, "All preachers want is your money". I find it interesting that they are not saying, "All gas stations want is your money", or, "All grocery stores want is your money". Try this...the next time you drive into a gas station, after you fill up your vehicle walk in and thank the attendant for caring so much about the need you had in life that they have just taken care of! Then try to walk out and get into your car and drive away without paying for the gas you put into your car. You'll find out very quickly how much they care about your need, they want your money! If you have a need in this world you have to pay for it with money! An exchange must be made. The nature of God's blessing is what you need to be successful in this world and the world can't give that to you.

There are those that don't believe what Jesus said about sowing and reaping and that's ok because they have what they want. But watch out the devil will use them to try and talk you into believing the same way they do..."God does not bless sowing money"...(side note: It's

a strange thing to me that the same people that want us to have life by the "keeping" of the law say that tithing is not something we need to do, and seed can't be money. Just an observation.) everyone that believes that lie lives in sickness & poverty. That is exactly where the devil wants them too! Then when it comes right down to it the people that believe this lie end up blaming God for all the problems in their lives and they begin to wear it like a badge of courage. **It's a badge of stupidity!** Proverbs tells us that God blesses and curses not. And the blessings of God make one rich. It all hinges on what you believe and understand from God's Word.

Mark 4:13 Jesus said, "Do you not understand this parable? How will you understand all the parables?"

He just finished telling the multitude that the entire Kingdom of God is just like a sower sowing seed. And if we don't understand the seed sown the devil comes immediately and steals what was sown. Again we have something the devil wants...our seed! Come on what do you want? Become a sower and see what The Lord will do. One of His promises is that He will continue to supply seed to the sower. If you don't believe money can be seed and you're broke...well what more can be said, your tradition has made the word of God of no effect in your monetary life.

Your seed can represent anything you want it to. God told Noah "while the earth remains seedtime and harvest would not cease". The earth is still here folks so find a field and sow some seed. I told a woman on the phone the other day to imagine driving down the highway going by a huge fertile field. It was screaming out very loud that it could bring forth if someone would just sow into it. But you didn't understand what the field was saying so you just kept driving. Then someone else drove by and did understand the field and sowed into it by faith in what the field said. The field brought forth in abundance from the seed that was sown and the person that sowed into the field prospered beyond all that he could ever ask or even think. Tend your garden, plow up the fallow ground, repent from your traditions that your field may be prepared to receive seed sown.

Self Deceived?

There is only one thing worst than being deceived by someone and that is being deceived by yourself. Here are some scriptures to look up that deal with areas of self deception. If you're really interested in knowing how to stay free of this, you'll take the time to look them up.

Hearing His Voice



Surprise, you have an adversary. I've jokingly mentioned how nice it would be if he had to materialize in a red union suit yielding a pitchfork every time he was within striking range, but since he doesn't have to the next best thing is that we know the word. First know that God's word is eternal and when you read it you should consider it as Him speaking to you. God wants His children to know His will and His word is His will. God never says something and does something against it. He doesn't fight against His own counsel and He follows the rules He sets. He has to because He is unchanging. His word is also unchanging.

Today we see many people studying the Hebrew roots of the faith. This is wonderful because every bit of **truth** and **understanding** we gain just makes us that much more capable of fighting old "Slewfoot". With study of the roots of the faith comes a real danger too, and we have to guard our hearts as well. It's real "tasty" (as Jeff would say) and can get us off trying to do to obtain, rather than hear the Voice of God by faith in order to obey. Unlike the days of the first covenant, today we have access to the Father directly through Y'shua. We don't have to have an earthy mediator to go to the Father each year. We can ask the Father directly for what we need at anytime. Not because of anything we've done, but by what Y'shua did. He is the word made flesh. So when we study his words (which by the way are God's words) and make a decision to obey them, we can keep the deceiver under our feet.

There is nothing better than studying the word to hear God's voice except walking with the leadership of the Holy Spirit as he directs us how to obey the word we've studied. Let me illustrate. We read in the word that there is a festival called "Passover" or "Pesach" in Hebrew. There aren't a lot of directions on keeping Passover, we just know we need to keep it. You could stumble through with the little written there, you could go to Jews to find out how they keep it, or you could go straight to the source, to the creator of Pesach and ask Him what to do.

Many folks want to "keep the word" to the "letter of the law" and with that comes the promise of a curse. Those may be hard words, but I'm quoting Galatians 3:10 "For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: for it is written, Cursed is every one that **continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them**. If we continue on we're told that we are to walk in hearing by faith the voice of the Father and not in attempting to "keep the law". I'm not asking anyone to break the law, that's just plain dangerous, but trust that "if you walk in the Spirit you won't fulfill the lust of the flesh".

We need to be listening to God by His Holy Spirit and what He has to say rather than what men who don't acknowledge His Son have to say. After all, what fellowship does light have with darkness?

I can't imagine going back to trying to figure out what to do on a daily basis without God. That's how I lived before I knew the Lord. I read this book and that looking for answers. I somehow knew that only the word of God had the answers, and once I met and became intimate with the Lord I didn't have to seek anymore.

Talmudic studies may have some truth in them, but folks lets

face it the men who wrote these books didn't know the Lord and actually rejected his life, his suffering, his death, his sacrifice, his holiness, his blood, his beauty, his worth, his love and everything he stood and stands for. Y'shua is the real thing. He is no counterfeit and I'm not about to reject what he did. I can't be good without him, I can't keep the commandments without him, I can't live without him and I refuse to go back to doing this thing and that hoping to find some sort of peace. He is my peace, he is my life, he is my hope of glory, he is my everything and I for one am not afraid to stand up and say so. If I confess him before men, he promised to confess me before the Father.

When he left this planet he left us here to do a job. He sent the Holy Spirit to empower us to do that job. The job is to preach repentance from the dead works that folks are getting back into. He sent us to preach righteousness and our access to it through the blood of Y'shua. He sent us to heal the sick, deliver the captive, to resurrect the dead, to crush the head of the serpent and love our enemies just like he loves us. It's not popular with men who are arrogant enough to think they can create their own righteousness by mastering every jot and tittle of the Hebrew language.

We have the Holy Spirit and he leads us into all righteousness. He is my "oral torah" and I intend to follow him right into glory. I am fully confident that he knows the will of the Father. I am fully confident that he will fill the temple (that's us folks) and the glory of the Lord will shine on this dark and dying land.
