The One Lost Sheep



Yeshua/Jesus told us that the good shepherd will leave the ninety and nine sheep in the sheepfold and go to look for that one lost sheep. We all need to really **know** this is true. At one time or another in our lives we will **be** that one lost sheep. When circumstances and situation come to knock us off our foundations, we need to know someone cares.

The Lord told us that the man (or woman) who builds his/her house on bedrock (hearing his voice and obeying it) will be building on firm foundation. A storm will come and the house will remain secure on that foundation. After a big storm everyone emerges from his/her home and estimates the damage the storm has done. The survivors come together and share how they made it through the storm. Sadly some never emerge from their homes. Some are so frightened by the storm that they “hole up” and become hermits. It matters little that they survived or that the house stood, the noise of the storm is all that is remembered. For this reason God will send a survivor to go look for those little frightened ones.

If you’ve ever dealt with an abused animal you know how hard it is to get it to trust you. You have to work over and over with it and “prove” yourself gentle and kind. People are even more inclined to be skittish after abuse than animals. The bad shepherd or “hireling” fleeces the sheep. There is definitely a difference in fleecing and sheering. Fleecing kills the animal, but sheering is a relief to a sheep. It will take more than just a surface, “I love you” for a wounded person to trust a shepherd. It will require natural love (meeting physical needs), emotional love (meeting the needs of the mind, will and emotions) and spiritual love (tapping into the Holy Spirit for spiritual power to overcome demonic forces).

Jeff had a vision of the difference between a wolf feeding its young and a sheep feeding its young. A true sheep (which is what an earthly pastor is) will produce fresh milk (fresh word-fresh manna) for its young. A wolf regurgitates for its young. A sheep is constantly viewing the horizon for birds of prey, wolves, coyotes and other enemies. A wolf works its way into the flock in order to kill, steal (in all three realms; natural, emotional and spiritual) and destroy. Both can be judged by words and deeds. A man/woman who constantly jokes about death, killing and stealing has many issues to be dealt with. A man/woman

who speaks love, speaks compassion and demonstrates them is a good shepherd.

The Father has given us many references to bad shepherds, wolves and hirelings. We aren't supposed to be freaked out by bad shepherds or wolves, but to be able to discern between them and choose the good.

It's hard to watch folks constantly be abused, ridiculed and embarrassed by leaders and loved ones. There is a temptation to tell the abused to run. Sadly the abused seem to have chains to their abusers and have a difficult time getting freed from their oppressors. That is where true intercession comes in. The intercessor first must pray for himself/herself to be able to hear God's voice in a given situation. It's easy to speak out of your head, but deliverance is from God and requires tapping into the Most High for true answers. After the intercessor is prepared he/she can then begin to listen for how to pray for the hurting abused sheep. The intercessor can't become a sheep thief, but the Father can put the solitary in families. He will go and rescue the one from the trap the lamb has fallen into. He will then entrust the care of that sheep to someone who is sensitive and has experience in dealing with the abused and neglected.

The Good Samaritan brought the wounded man to an inn and tended to his wounds. He then left resources for the innkeeper to tend to the recovering victim. So it is with our Father; He rescues and then entrusts. If you know that you are abused or have been abused you may have areas in your soul that need healing.

Psalms 23

*The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters. He **restoreth my soul**: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake. Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me. Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD for ever.*

*3 John 2 Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as **thy soul prospereth**.*

We all want to prosper, but complete prosperity comes only as our souls (mind, will and emotions) are prospering. If our souls are wounded we can't truly prosper. The hurt soul needs to be subjected to the healing flow from the Father, through the Son and confirmed by the Holy Spirit. For this process to begin; we need a good shepherd (flesh and blood human) to take us to THE good Shepherd. If you're anything like us you've had more than your fair share of nasty shepherds. Most are nothing more than hirelings. Some are merely ignorant of the truth and flying by the seat of their pants rather than walking in the wisdom of God. The worst part is there are those who are nothing more than wolves dressed like sheep. I ask myself, "Where did those wolves get that fleece to make that costume? Who died to cloth that ugly wolf?"

A really loving human shepherd should encourage you to hear God's voice, not be insistent that you listen to his human teaching and exclude others. A good human shepherd will leave the healthy thriving flock all carefully fenced in with prayer and angels and seek out the one little hurting one. Because we are sheep we have a real tendency to want to be led, but we have to be careful who we follow. Don't follow just any Tom, Dick or hairy sheep you see. The sheep under his/her care should be getting healthy if not already healthy. They should be increasing in all three realms; the spiritual, the emotional and the physical. The good shepherd is about the whole Body although he has certain sheep in his care. He shouldn't live in mansions while his sheep eek out a living and barely make it by. He should be the greatest servant in the bunch. He would never insist that everyone else do all the work, although he will insist on enough time to hear God for his responsibilities to the flock.

Don't be satisfied with anything less than the best. We're all looking for good pastors, but we need to have a biblical foundation on which to build. Here are some references that will help you in your search for godly teaching, and godly care.

The Order of God

When we hear the word *order* many things come to mind, some natural and some spiritual. Order is a simple principle, but it can have deep layers of importance to the believer. Let's look at the natural definition of order.



If we consider the order of God we want to first recognize that God is bigger than our finite (measurable) minds. Our minds are susceptible to the limitations of scope and size by decree of God Himself. We can't think beyond what God has ordained or ordered. He put certain limitations within humanity because sin was coming. God thinks in eternal terms, we think in linear terms. He was able to see the end from the beginning. When God ordered everything natural He not only ARRANGED everything, He COMMANDED, He DESTINED, He ORDAINED, REGULATED and ISSUED ORDERS with one word. His Son was/is/shall ever be the Torah made flesh. It took time for His seed to go into the Earth and bring forth, but he did manifest. God's order began in the beginning.

I want to take this down to the lowest common denominator or to the simplest terms so everyone reading can understand. God used order to begin, continue and end His faith. His faith was sent in a word to destroy the works of the adversary 1 John 3:8. In His Son Yeshua He accomplished all, but there was a first, a second, a third and so on.

Order is what comes first, what happens next and what happens last. God was able to see the "dominoes fall" when He spoke the first word and He was able to see the end results in His first words and in His last words.

God hasn't had to add a single thing to what He origi-



nally said. When He rested on the seventh day He had said enough to make everything that needed to happen, happen. (Genesis 2:3) His Son was with Him in the beginning. (John 1:1-4) If we consider the creation itself we see order; the first day, the second day, etc. to the seventh day. He made the heavens and earth BEFORE he made man. Why? Consider if the order had been reversed. Man with no environment would have died. God has a reason for order. We can't always see order, but we don't need to see oxygen to enjoy its benefits. We don't need to know how our brains work to know they are functioning. We do a whole lot of trusting or believing that we aren't even aware of. We call it "taking things for granted", but in all actuality we have faith built into our beings.

I've said all this to have you begin to consider and look for order in your bibles. When you read the word look for such things as: first, then, before, beginning, last and anything that speaks of order. God knew that things would get out of order. He wasn't surprised that the office of the apostle would be forgotten; He made provision for it to be revived. In order for you to further understand your apostle Jeff and others you may come across I share the concept of order. The apostle's job is to put order back into your lives. If you know what to expect you will begin to see ORDER manifest in your life. You will begin to see chaos and how it got in. You will also see it leave! No apostle, no order. No order, all you will see is chaos. Below are two definitions of chaos. We are about removing chaos from your life by bringing order.

a : a state of utter confusion

b : a confused mass or mixture

Weaponry of Our Warfare is Love

2 Cor 10:3-6 For though we walk in the flesh, we **do not** war after the flesh:(For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the

knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ; And having in a readiness to **revenge** all disobedience, when your obedience is fulfilled.

*Eph 6:10-20 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. Put on the whole armour of God that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench **all** the fiery darts of the wicked. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints; And for me, that utterance may be given unto me, that I may **open my mouth boldly**, to make known the mystery of the gospel, For which I am an ambassador in bonds: **that therein I may speak boldly**, as I ought to speak.*

*Isa 59:17-18 For he put on righteousness as a breastplate, and a helmet of salvation upon his head; and he put on the **garments of vengeance** for clothing, and was **clad with zeal as a cloke**. According to their deeds, accordingly he will **repay**, fury to his adversaries, **recompence** to his enemies; to the islands he will **repay recompense**.*

Last month we talked about the weapons of our warfare being love weapons. For lack of space I left out the garments of vengeance and the cloke of zeal. Today we would see a very different soldier than Paul was seeing in his day. We'd see a man dressed in camouflage and he'd be carrying sophisticated armor and weaponry. Just as it was in Paul's time, so it is in our time; we don't wrestle against flesh and blood. Unlike the zealots of Paul's day the early believers used love as their armory and weaponry. The most effective time in the Body of Christ was the time right after Yeshua/Jesus left the earth. Why; because his lessons on love were fresh in their hearts and minds. Everything he said and did was about love. He healed led of love, he delivered led of love, he fed the people led of love and he gave the ultimate gift, his life, led of love. The further away from his life on the earth man got, the further away from love mankind became. So why is it changing today? Because he's coming back!

God is love and love NEVER fails. That is an awesome promise. When we stand on the commandments of love we are promised to NEVER fail. I don't know about you, but I really like to succeed. I really do NOT like to fail. I don't work hard at pleasing God just to fail. We have so many promises that hinge on love. Faith works by love (Gal. 5:6). Love covers a multitude of sin (1 Pet. 4:8 & James 5:20).

At the beginning of this lesson I listed three scripture references. Each one deals with the armor of believers. We see that vengeance and zeal are to be worn like garments. One is a motivating force, the other is retaliation. Another word for zeal would be boldness. The early believers after Yeshua/Jesus left had to have holy boldness in order to stand in the face of severe persecution. The word bold and its synonyms are used 31 times in the New Testament.

NT:3954

parrhesia (par-rhay-see'-ah); from NT:3956 and a derivative of NT:4483; all out-spokenness, i.e. frankness, bluntness, publicity; by implication, assurance: KJV - bold (X - ly, -ness, -ness of speech), confidence, X freely, X openly, X plainly (-ness).

Zeal or boldness to stand in the face of death is a God given gift. The apostle Paul was a bold or zealous man. He initially used boldness to persecute the Body of Christ. Our Messiah took his zealously seriously. It moved him off his throne. The Body today lacks this zeal, this boldness. It is a huge area of intercession for us. We concentrate on it all the time. God's boldness comes when His hand is apparent. Paul asked God to grant him boldness.

Acts 4:29-32 And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word, By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus. And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness. And the multitude of them that believed were of one heart and of one soul.

I trust that you will take this verse and pray for the Body to have boldness. We need the zeal of God restored and NOW. A man who is totally confident that the Most High God is backing him will do amazing things. A man

who is iffy about whether he's in God's will is hesitant. We need no hesitation. We need to know we are the righteousness of God in Christ! Then and only then will we do great exploits for our God.

Vengeance is a word most believers tend to avoid. The vengeance we are supposed to exert these days is not on our fellow man, but on the adversary. Our vengeance is done in the spirit realm against and unseen but very tangible enemy. First of all a deep study on this sort of vengeance will require more room than this entire newsletter can afford. Secondly, we aren't ready for vengeance by the command and requirements of 2 Cor. 10:6. If you're really interested in learning about this you need to meet the first requirements. You need to have engraved on your heart the first principles of the oracles of God. You have no need to progress further until you do. We aren't sending half prepared or half armed soldiers into a horrific battle.

Repentance from Dead Works

Heb 6:1 "Not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works..."



I am going to bring something out in a very few words that we all must understand. Have you ever asked the Holy Spirit to show you what repentance from dead works means?

What repentance from dead works is? Many years ago I asked that question. I have run into leaders in the church that claim to understand what I tell them but won't and don't teach it. I simply believe they won't teach it because they don't really know what repentance from dead works is. So if you will allow me to try and write it for you to read I believe you will begin to see what true repentance from dead works is.

1. The first thing we must understand is repentance. I think all of us do understand what repentance is but let's touch on it for a second. To repent "from" something means you are "doing" something and you want or need to repent "from" it. When you repent "from" that thing you

are "doing" is to stop "doing" that thing turn around and go the opposite direction. Agreed? OK let's go on.

2. We are told in Hebrews 6 that "dead works" is that thing that we need to repent "from". Most of the main line denominations in America say that this means we are to repent from sin. Now keep in mind Paul says this is ONE of the principles of the doctrines of Christ so a brand new believer should be taught this right out of the chute. All of us should have been taught this doctrinal principle the first month in Sunday school. But were we? No!

The apostle John writes that if we say we have no sin we are liars and the truth is not in us. If we repented from sin then we should be able to say we have no sin. Are you following me? I trust you do. So that can only mean that "dead works", the thing we should have repented "from" is **not** sin. Shocker huh! I told you this was going to be in few words and I meant it because this is not rocket science. It's the gospel and the gospel is simple, very simple. Dead works is works that are dead. What are dead works? Dead works is trying to be righteous by doing something. If we were supposed to repent from dead works we did **not** repent from sin but repented from trying to work our way into God's grace and not receive it by faith through the sacrifice of His Son.

The first foundational stone that the body of Christ should be built upon is understanding that we need to repent from thinking we can do a work that will be acceptable to God in place of the work of Y'shua/Jesus. Repentance from dead works is simply to stop going about trying to establish our own righteousness. If you will look in Hebrews 5: 13 you will see that the very thing that kept them from being teachers is the fact that they were unskillful in the **word of righteousness** and were in need of milk. They still did not understand, even though they were born again, that there was nothing they could do to help themselves into the Kingdom. The thing that kept them from grasping this sort of repentance was their traditions. They were entering back into animal sacrifice and sprinkling of blood, trying to do what had always been done and what had always been done had been done away with (those blood sacrifices and other such ordinances). Paul wanted to write to them about the importance of understanding that the Levitical priesthood not being necessary and that the order of the Melchisadec priesthood had been re-established in its place. But he couldn't write much to them about it because they were not able to hear it yet simply because they were not standing on the first foundational stone of repentance from dead works.

Here, as they say, in a nutshell is what I believe we must begin to walk on. We have been taught that when we were born again we repented from sin. Because we

have been taught that every time we do sin the devil can bring condemnation because we think we should have repented from it. So we “try” and repent from it again and again and again. Then there comes a time when we either begin to hide it or just plain quit trying to live what we have been taught should be a Christian life. Is there any wonder why there is little to no power in the church? When the truth really sinks in that true repentance from dead works is not repenting from sin you will be made free. Jesus made you righteous, you were shown there was nothing you could do but freely accept Him as your sacrifice and resurrected savior, and no matter who you were that day you repented from trying to work your way into heaven. You repented from dead works. You can’t repent from sin in the flesh you have now. You can confess it as sin to Him knowing He is faithful and just to forgive you of that sin but He is your righteousness. Get on the first stone that the builders rejected or it will crush you. He is the only one that can hold that weight stop trying to pick it up.

Ministry to the Body

When you are praying for yourself consider that whatever you pray for yourself is influencing the entire Body. We need to get past the idea that our little congregations are the “whole enchilada”. Otherwise we tend to be self-ish, self-centered and off balance.

1 Cor 12:26 And whether one member suffer, all the members suffer with it; or one member be honoured, all the members rejoice with it.

The members or “cells” as I like to think of them of the Body in Christ have needs just as much as you and I in Texas and New Mexico (and all points beyond us) have. We need to consider this in our prayer time. When you’re standing against a weakness in yourself, remember that it is impacting the entire Body.

Rom 14:7 For none of us liveth to himself, and no man dieth to himself.

It’s time for us to think we or us instead of me, myself and I. It’s time to live and move and have out being as a whole Body, moving at the command of the Head. Yeshua is waiting for the Body to stand up and walk as one unified being. Only through unity of the faith will we do this.

Pray for the Body. Pray for boldness to manifest so that we will lay hands on the sick. So we’ll cast out devils rather than talk about them. So we’ll raise the dead and a thousand other things we ought to be doing.

Here is a list of things we see that the Body needs. Ask, believe and receive them for us all and not just for yourself. Thank God for already providing these things in Yeshua/Jesus!
