



Effective Prayer continued



Last month we looked at *John 15:7* "If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you." It is one pattern for receiving from God through prayer that Yeshua/Jesus left us

with. We broke it up into steps that we must follow and I'll put the list down again for you to follow.

Abide or live in Yeshua/Jesus (our part)

Have his words ABIDE or live in us (our part)

Ask what we will (our part)

Wait for what we ask for (our part)

God does what we ask (His part)

I want to revisit step one with more depth. God is love and so if we're told to abide in Him, we must abide in love. Love is the first fruit of the spirit. If we are walking led of the Holy Spirit we will bear fruit from the spirit out to flesh. Walking in love is something that requires death of self. The fruit on our "tree" is not for us, it is for those on the outside of our individual temples and the corporate temple which is the Body of Christ (the Anointed one and his anointing). Love is for the loveless. Joy is for the down trodden. Peace is for those in chaos. Long suffering is for the feeble minded and weak. Gentleness is for the violent. Goodness is for the ones in captivity to sin and wickedness. Faith is for those in doubt and unbelief. Meekness is for the proud. Temperance is for those who have no self control. You don't eat off your own tree, but must be willing because you abide in love to allow the

unlovely to eat off your tree. The good news is that there is always seed in the fruit.

Gen 1:11 And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, and the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed is in itself, upon the earth: and it was so.

The one who eats your fruit will plant the seed within the fruit. It is planted in his/her heart and can then bring forth other fruit. So you abide in love by being like the one who is love. You give love and joy and peace and kindness etc. Abiding in him is abiding in love. You'll have to climb up on a cross to do this, but in the end you ask what you will and it shall be done unto you!

Abiding is both receiving what Yeshua/Jesus already did in his life, death, burial, and resurrection and then abiding in love. There are so many scriptures dealing with how to walk in love that this will require research on your part. I will give you a few to "chew on". As you walk these out you will see healing come into your body. You will see prosperity dwell in your home. You will see the Lord sit down with you at your dinner table!

Love is patient, love is kind, love doesn't keep records of suffered wrongs

Love thinks no evil

Love edifies while knowledge puffs up and brings pride

Love is long suffering, love never envies

We can be led by love (the spirit of compassion)

On My Way



By the time most of you are reading this I should be touching down in Minsk, Belarus. I'm sure I'm overwhelmed with the sights, smells and sounds of a different culture. I've really steeped myself in the language and done a little research into the history and culture, but really wanted to experience the real thing without too much input from outside sources. Our first few days in Belarus will be set aside for resting and recouping from the jetlag that we know we'll face. I'm glad I'm with others who have blazed this trail before. I already know that I'll hear way more Russian than I know because I've sat in the Russian Ladies' bible study for two and a half months and am amazed at how much I don't know. My only consolation during the studies is that they are kind enough to translate after they converse in Russian. The women graciously allow me to read some of the Russian bible text in their native tongue and have never yet laughed at my rendition of their tongue. At the last meeting I read the Lord's Prayer in Russian. Our eldest member of the study, Rachel, coached me every step of the way. It was clear she had this text memorized in Russian just as we all have it committed to memory in English. Later she prayed in Ukrainian and although most of what she said I didn't understand, I found myself weeping at the sincerity and love I could feel as she spoke to the Father. It was so beautiful.

God is so good folks. You have no idea how flabbergasted I am that He chose me to make this trip. I truthfully had no idea when He told me to learn Russian six years ago that I'd ever step one foot in that country. I must be honest to say I had no desire to do so. I thought I'd be ministering to Russian Jews in Israel or here in the states. My first contact with a Russian Jew was at Nof Ginosaur on the Galilee. He was a guitarist and refused to speak in Russian. He'd left his native land 10 years earlier and was quite content to call himself Hebrew. When I feebly attempted to say a few words in Russian he told me that I had no accent. I laughed within myself knowing I'd never really spoken to anyone before and couldn't imagine that I'd said a single thing accurately.


Forgive me as I digress. I really began this as a letter to say thank you to all of you who sent money to help me, to help Snezhana or the help the orphans. I am hop-

ing (the Belarusian's willing) to bring back photos of the baby orphans and the orphans we touch at the summer camps. When I return I really want to have a meeting where everyone can come eat, fellowship and see pictures of this first trip to Russia. We will work toward that goal after I get back and am rested from a long adventure.

Do continue to pray for us during the month of June as we may face many challenges. We are looking for favor with the directors of the orphanages and the doctors and nurses at the "abandoned baby hospital". We want to be able to share the message of the gospel without any restrictions. Also pray that we'll be able to find lots of diapers to buy once we get there. I've been told they have warehouse stores and we should be able to buy them there.

Again, let me say thank you for all your prayers, your letters and gifts to help me go and bless the people we see in Belarus.

The bibles finally arrived in Uzbekistan after more than two months in transit. When I arrived at Snezhana's home this week she was on the phone. I could tell immediately she was talking long distance. I learned once she got off the phone that she had been talking to her family in Uzbekistan (they were speaking Uzbek). They had received the box one day earlier. They also told her that their church was having a special celebration because of the arrival of the bibles. Snezhana's family told her the box had arrived open, but everything was still inside. Now we pray for their protection as the vast majority of the population is Muslim. We as American believers are so blessed to have bibles everywhere and to be free to read them. We don't know how long that will be true so we need to be vigilant to walk in the word everyday. We take for granted that we will always have them, but our leaders are already working to take the bible out of every area of our lives. We thank God for getting the bibles safely to Uzbekistan.

We have yet to hear from Nigeria after sending them a second box of bibles. Please keep this before the Lord as we really want to hear that they arrived.

Are The Early Days Gone?



Matt 13:22 He also that received seed among the thorns is he that hears the word; and the care of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, choke the word, and he becomes unfruitful.

All of us would like to say, "This does not apply to me." "I have received the word and understand it so the evil one can't come into my heart and steel the word that was planted." Yet very few that say they have received the word sown in their hearts bring forth fruit. A very large percentage of people that say they are born again have never led another person to salvation.

Is it possible that the seed sown has come up among thorns? Jesus defined the thorns as: the cares of this world and the deceitfulness of riches. Most that have heard the good news of the kingdom received it with great joy, but then after a while things change and they grow cold. The zeal and love of God and His kingdom drop in order of importance and end up down at the bottom of the "to do" list. The same brand new believers used to want to scream out at any and all that would listen about what God had done for them, but now among all the hustle and bustle of this world's demands nothing is heard from them. Every time they might want to stick their head out and tell someone about the saving grace of God, they get stuck in the back or on the side of the rib cage by those same thorns. Then the word gets choked and this same person becomes unfruitful.

If all of us would take the time to really ponder on what the cares of this world are, I believe we would all see something very interesting. I have found that the cares of this world bring **in** the deceitfulness of riches and as soon as we begin to get deceived by the riches in our lives, the cares become undeniably powerful and consume all our time. It is impossible to be about the Father's business when we are so deep into our own.

I have met men that have found a way of justifying that scenario. They turn God's kingdom ways into businesses and say they are working for God! Nope, wrong. What fellowship does light have with darkness? Evil with good? The cares of this world have become so seemingly necessary to exist in this world that the devil has deceived men with the very thorns none of them claimed to have a problem with. Again most would say, "This does not apply to

me." "I have received the word and understand it, so the evil one can't come into my heart and steel the word that was planted." Well he has and is doing so at an unprecedented rate.

Consider the early days of your salvation...remember how great everything became. It didn't seem to matter what came your way everything was going to be all right. You were fresh and new and so was everything else around you. If your job wasn't perfect it was ok because God saved you. If your spouse wasn't perfect it was ok because God saved you. If your car wasn't perfect it was ok because God saved you. Because of everything being ok and the fact that no care was bothering you, your life began to prosper. Your health even improved and stayed that way. Then with the prosperity and everything going well in your life the need and dependence on God just wasn't as necessary as before. So you find more time to focus on the stuff and less need to seek the God that saved you. Now all of a sudden your job isn't perfect, your spouse isn't perfect, your car isn't perfect and it all matters! What has happened? The thorns have choked the word that was so lovingly and readily received and the person it was sown into has become unfruitful.

So I ask you, "Are the early days gone"? Are you so wrapped up in the cares of this world and the deceitfulness of riches because it seems you have to be to survive? You do realize that is what this type of deception does. It causes people to think that the condition they are in, has to be that way or everything will fly apart at the seams.

There is a day ahead where each one of us will get to see the Master face to face. I want more than anything to stand there in His presence as a fruitful son not lukewarm, caught up in all the cares this world had to offer. I refuse to become tangled up by bushes bearing thorns trying to choke me so I am not fit for the Master's use. Your early days could be referred to, as your first love and I believe the Holy Spirit is calling all who have ears to hear back to their first love. The condition we were all in when nothing was in the way of our first love and we were totally depending on Him for everything. If God weren't in it you would rather give up your life than participate no matter how small a thing. The Master is calling those who have ears to hear;

Matt 11:28-30 Come to me; all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light."

Righteousness Consciousness



1 Cor 1:30 But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:
Rom 5:19 For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous.

Let me begin by making this statement: Righteousness is the biggest blessing of being born-again! It is the greatest blessing of the New Covenant simply because all of the other things of God are relative to it. Being in right standing with the Father is what righteousness means. Now before we read the scripture the Lord has given us here lets look at a couple things and establish them in our hearts. We need to know that righteousness is a free gift. Another thing I want to mention to you before we read simply because I want it to be in your mind as we read the word concerning this subject: Remember that there are always words that will have double meanings. I am talking about words that have one meaning in the church house and the same word will have a different meaning when used down town.

You use this word righteousness all the time. We see in the Constitution of the United States government and in the way this country was established the use of the basic fundamental meaning of righteousness. Righteousness literally means being in right standing or really the English word righteous means "rightness", being right, having rights and privileges. Do we not have a Bill of Rights? Do you know what that is? If you explained that or amplified the name of that document, "the Bill of Rights", it would be something like this: it is the bill of being in right standing with United States government. Now, I don't know how many of you have ever traveled out side the United States some of you have I'm sure. When you come back into that booth where the customs man stands you are not **legally** on United States soil until that customs agent has cleared you and you arrive over on the other side of the gate. Let me tell those of you that may have never had the opportunity to travel outside the US. It's a cold feeling being over on the outside when you walk up to that customs agent and he's looking you up one side and down the other. He has the right to search you, he has the right to reach over and look in your ear if he wants to. Because your

ear doesn't belong to you as long as you are on the outside of that fence. Now once you get over on the other side and get cleared through customs you again have certain rights and privileges. You have certain rights as a United States citizen. As long as you are obeying the laws of this government and not infringing upon other people or trying to over throw this government, you have certain rights and privileges simply because you are a citizen of the United States. You'll never appreciate fully those rights and privileges until you go into another country that doesn't have those rights or privileges and hang around over there for a while. You will find out your rights as an American certainly don't apply there. Let me tell you, you don't know what it's like when you stand up and stomp your foot and say look I've got some rights around here and no body pays any attention to you. They just go right ahead and strip search you while you're trying to get them to understand you have rights you are an American! They don't care about any of that. They are going by their laws not the US's and you have NO rights in their country.

That is exactly what the bible calls righteousness, being in right standing with God. Plus, thank God, we have an advocate with the Father. The Lord is the advocate of the church or body of Christ. Do you know what the word advocate means? It means a lawyer or a counselor. You've got legal representation in heaven even when you break the rules of the kingdom of God. You can go to your lawyer and confess your guilt and when the devil starts to come against you because of it, your lawyer will get on your case. He'll fix it for you and He'll cleanse you from all unrighteousness. In other words He'll keep you in right standing before the Father (the judge). Isn't that great? Praise God Jesus is our advocate between you and the devil and you and the judge! You need to understand that. As we look into the scripture let me remind you of this, when you come across words in the book of Romans and 1st and 2nd Corinthians particularly in the Apostle Paul's writings this subject of righteousness is the key word to all of Paul's letters. Righteousness is the main key to the entire reason for all of his writing. If you get an understanding of the word righteousness you won't have any problem understanding the New Testament because that's what it's all about. It is about Jesus of Nazareth putting us in right standing with the Father with HIS righteousness. Occasionally you'll find the word justified and justification but in the Greek text it is the same word. The translators have taken the liberty to translate it justification in one place and righteousness in another, but it literally means the same thing. It takes on a more legal aspect

when it talks about being justified. For instance in a court of law where there is true justice and judgment has been made and the judge has judged a man as free, he walks out of that courtroom justified. He was innocent or *justified* in what he did. In other words that courtroom and its judge has justified him and you better keep your hands off of him because he is just as free as you are. Can you see that? That is another side of righteousness. Jesus has made us to be in right standing with the Father. The high court of heaven has justified you and pointed the scepter of righteousness at you and satan better leave you alone.

Now if you do not stand for that righteousness and that redemption there is little to nothing that God can do for you. Righteousness give to you by Jesus is part of your armor. Even though you are redeemed, the devil is a liar, thief, a killer and a destroyer and he doesn't have to have a legal right to come at you if he can make you let him come at you through your consent. He will do everything he can get away with coming at you. But if you'll stand on your rights as a justified child of God, he doesn't have any room to stand and can't touch you. Now if you will apply this over in the area of our Bill of Rights here in America, the same thing follows suit. Let's take for example the Emancipation Proclamation that was made back at the close of the civil war. It stated that there was absolute freedom in this country for everyone and that it was going to be absolutely that way. But it was 100 years before the black man stuck his heels in the ground and said you're not going to enslave us or treat us as second class citizens any more. He said to himself and to all around him, "I'm not going to ride in the back of the bus". At this point in history we are going to find out if this Bill of Rights has got anything to it or not. We're going to find out if the law that was put on the books really works. And thank God it did. When somebody stood on it, it worked. What I want to point out to you is that black man was as free 100 years ago as he was 100 years later. He was as free in 1865 as he was in 1965. As far as the law was concerned he was just as free the day that law was passed as the day he began to demand it be upheld. Why weren't they living free in that 100-year period? Because no one was putting the demand on the legal side of the law that said they were free. The same thing is true in the world of the spirit. In fact that is a perfect picture of what goes on in the world of the spirit because satan was the author of all that slavery junk. He is the one that puts people in bondage and he knows that if natural non-born-again men

get the chance to lord it over another man they will take it. All led by the devil of course. It doesn't matter what color people are, you could be pink and oppressors will put their heel on your neck. When slavery was allowed in America satan fanned it with oppression and terrorism to ruin this countries testimony to the rest of the world of what a free people living in a free country could accomplish. But thank God he got beat there too.

Again the same thing is true in the world of the spirit. When we take authority and stand on that right standing. When we stand up to sickness, disease, poverty and anything else that the thief comes to do we will see a change. He is all about stealing, killing and destroying us. We have to just stand up and say, "Look here devil I've got rights in the kingdom of God. I have been delivered from the authority of darkness and have been translated into the kingdom of God's dear Son. You are not going to put that on my household or me. I am not going to put up with it because I'm the righteousness of God." It will work, it will work! I've heard some people say, "Well you know I tried that for two days." Let's use the illustration that we had earlier, there were individual black people, Indian people and there were individual men down through the ages that stood for their rights individually and went right on over the top. Yet there were other people that stood up for their rights a couple of days, but after the pressure got so great they just quit. And it is still the same way today in the natural as well as in the spirit realm. But if people would decide that they were just not going to give up on their rights. If they would decide that something else was going to have to give no matter what came their way. If they would decide that they were standing on their rights until the end. Well something else would give way because the law works on their behalf. Now you get to dealing in heaven's affairs and I am going to tell you something folks. In heaven the law works on your behalf! God's word is law! When you know God said it, and you stand on it, you have all of heaven backing your rights as a citizen of the kingdom of God. There are no corrupt judges in heaven. There are no corrupt law enforcement agencies in heaven when it comes to the word of God. Satan does not have a prayer when a believer will stand on what God has said in His word.

I hope this has given you some clear insight into what righteousness means. It is right standing with God. Righteousness is the ability to stand in the presence of a holy God without a sense of sin or fear. No condemnation knowing you belong there because Jesus said you do. He fixed it for you.

Confessions for the Family

The Husband



These verses are for husbands. Because God has put the husband as head over the wife and family we want to begin where God began. We recognize the place of the man as the covering, protection and provider over the home. Women can use these verses if their husbands aren't walking in the fullness of their calling. Men can use them to confess when they want to see more power

in their lives. Children can confess them for their fathers.

Submission isn't oppression. Submission is seeing that God has order; 1st, 2nd and so on not better than. The man was created before or 1st, but the woman was within the man and drawn from him. We are to walk together, in union. Submission is like the law of lift and drag applied to the law of gravity. It causes a heavier than air machine to fly! *Eph 5:22-24 Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord. For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body. Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in every thing.*

Husbands are to present their wives to themselves, glorious, spotless without wrinkles. Hey ladies, here is a verse to deal with wrinkles. Our men are supposed to deal with wrinkles by confession. I like that. They do so by a gentle washing of the water of the word. They are supposed to love their wives like our Lord loved the ekklesia! They are supposed to nurture their wives like they would care for their own bodies. Ok no slacking off on those push ups men! We are in a partnership in marriage not a competition. We are supposed to be for one another and we can see this here. If the Lord acted a certain way towards the called out ones, husbands are to do as much for their wives. Love em boys. *Eph 5:24-28 Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in every thing. Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish. So ought men to love their wives as their own bodies. He that loveth his wife loveth himself.*

Husbands are supposed to love their wives (1 Cor. 13 love that is), but it's mighty hard to love their wives if their wives won't submit to them. Oh yes, wives are to submit to their OWN husbands, not to the pastor over the husband.

Col 3:18-19 Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as it is fit in the Lord. Husbands, love your wives, and be not bitter against them.

This verse speaks of knowing your wife. I'm constantly surprised when I hear women tell me that they haven't been intimate with their husbands in months or even years. I'm also surprised when I hear that spouses rarely talk. How can you know someone if you never commune with him/her? We know each other in our home. We know each other's weaknesses, we know each other's strengths. We build each other up with our conversation and with all areas of intimacy. If we don't then the adversary slips in. I know that my husband has a tendency to react to things in a certain way and I don't allow strife to come in because of it. I just pray in the spirit when the adversary plays on his weaknesses. You will notice men that at the end of this verse it speaks of prayers being hindered. Knowing your wife and dwelling with her according to that knowledge will help you see your prayers answered. *1 Peter 3:7 Ye husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered.*

Your home is your kingdom. Husbands, you are accountable for everything that enters in through the gateway. You will answer for the programs you watch on TV, to the games you play, to the things that are done within the walls. If what you do divides, you will answer for it. The adversary is about division. Division isn't separation. You can be apart and yet not divided against one another. Be for one another. Don't let any strife in. Don't be envious over each other's jobs. *Matt 12:25 And Jesus knew their thoughts, and said unto them, Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation; and every city or house divided against itself shall not stand:*

Here we see that husbands watch for wives and children's souls. They truly will give account to God for the souls of their family members. We as wives and children are supposed to obey them as God has given them rule over us. We want our men to do the job with joy and not with grief. Be quik to submit wives. Husbands do your jobs with joy! *Heb 13:17 Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief: for that is unprofitable for you.*

We all need to pay attention when envy or strife rear their ugly heads. We sure don't need confusion or evil works in our lives. So when you are dealing with family issues and you see one of these show up, press into love. *James 3:16 For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work.*
