THE SIZE OF YOUR SEED

While praying over the letters we were about to send out to you this past week the Lord spoke this to me. "Don't judge your success by the size of your seed" or in other words by the things you are doing in this natural realm. We're called to be faithful over the little we're entrusted with in the temporal realm so that we can be made masters of over much in the eternal realm.

If you look at an acorn it is hard to imagine that one day it will be a huge oak tree. How does an acorn go from such a small amount of substance into a huge tree? Only God knows. That's how it is with the things we are asked to be stewards over, we take the seeds we are given and sow them. A supernatural process (the process of faith in action) happens and something very small begins to "grow" and it increases, but how it increases we just don't know. God declared from the beginning how the seed would produce and by His declaration all things in the kingdom function the same way.

Each seed has its own body, but it looks very different from what it will become. We have no idea what our natural seed will yield eternally when sown into the kingdom; it will be however, very much different. It exchanges its original body for a new body! So it will be with the things we do here in this "natural" or temporal realm. Everything we do is sowing. There are those who don't believe that what they do is sowing, but anyone with the eyes of faith can see that they are also reaping with every movement or action they do. Just because they are unwilling and therefore unable to see, doesn't mean they aren't paying the consequences of every action they make or take.

So today when you're doing something and asking yourself if what you're doing has value, just remember. Never judge your success by the size of the seed your have sown, seeds sown never remain tiny when tended and allowed to grow! Also, just a quick reminder: God gives seed to sowers. If you look at everything you do as seed sown, you can believe that God will give you more seed. Just make sure and plant your seed in the kingdom of God. It would be a shame for you to spend an eternity with no "trees" because you spent all your seed on temporal things.

PREPARING FOR THE DAYS AHEAD



Here are some areas we covet your prayers over. We are still in the infancy stages of preparing for Taos. Pray we'll continue to have hearing ears, and seeing eyes. BIRDS OF THE AIR PLANT UNWANTED SEED

I find it very interesting that no matter where I travel there is plant life growing up from the ground. In most cases I have no idea what it is that is popping up from the ground, but my ignorance doesn't stop it from growing. In the process of my time on this earth I have come to understand that birds sit in one place and eat what they find there and fly to another place and do the same thing all over again. While in flight to the next spot, they deposit most of what was eaten never giving thought to the fact that they are planting seed wherever they go. I have also seen certain birds that will eat anything from a French fry to fancy store bought birdseed. It appears to me that some birds can get away with eating just about anything they want to pick up and swallow. Do you know that some birds eat things that would be poisonous to us? They then fly on to the next place dropping and planting the seed from the poisonous plant onto the ground. The ground doesn't seem to care what is put in it or onto it. The ground just causes whatever seed is placed within it to sprout without much if any assistance; i.e., breaking up the soil, fertilization, and normal watering.

I can hear you folks reading this almost laughingly and wondering, "What in the world is he telling us this for"? I also know that some of you as you are spiritually led have already heard the Spirit of God and He has given you revelation from what has been written here. Consider this for just a moment... we have nothing to do with planting bad seed that we find growing in our yards. The majority of that unwanted growth was seed dropped by the birds of the air. They certainly don't care whose yard they put it in as they are only doing what comes naturally. On the other hand when we plant seed that we want sown, it can be very difficult to get it to sprout and stay healthy to its full term; to the place of bringing forth desirable fruit. Why do you suppose that is? Consider that the unwanted seed sprouts wherever it's dropped and seems to grow quickly and brings forth its fruit (more unwanted seed) without any tending. Who are those "birds" any way? Selah!



Thanks to the generosity of all of you we were able to take a special trip to Austin, Texas this month and meet the evangelist we told you about that lives in India. The Lord knit us together with Barnabas some six or seven years ago and we've yearned to meet face to face for all these years. After the recent devastation in India his importance to that country becomes greater all the time.

Back when we were both at the TV network and I was working as the webmaster, Barnabas found the network's web while surfing the Internet. He began emailing me and I passed the baton to Jeff. Barnabas' questions were more in Jeff's field and so the friendship and brotherhood began. We have been praying for Barnabas and the folks in India ever since. Believers are so persecuted in India, and much of it goes unreported. The law enforcement in that country turns a deaf ear to the reports of such persecution. Barnabas has lost a couple jobs because of his outspoken love for Y'shua/Jesus and Father God. He has lost a pastor and much of their worship has to be underground. One pastor and his sons were burned alive in their van while camping. His wife and daughter watched helplessly as the Hindis set the van ablaze. The women had been sleeping in an adjacent tent and were forced to watch the spectacle. All of this happened just this year.

Barnabas also shared the stories of Chinese believers who are in prison camps where they make the toys we find in our "Happy Meals". The devil is very blatant in his cruelty. These believers are forced to work while standing in buckets of liquid. The liquid is a "mild" form of acid. After so long the feet and limbs of the believers rot away and they die horrific deaths. Don't quit buying the meals, but when you eat at McDonald's pray for the Chinese believers.

We in America are pretty ignorant to the persecution in other lands. Barnabas' zeal for the Lord rekindled us in a very new way. We are already seeing signs of persecution of believers here in America. We would be fooling ourselves to say "It could never happen here". Without godly representation in government it will happen here, and sooner rather than later.

Barnabas also told of the visiting American ministries and how much of what we're being told about them is inaccurate. We have to remain zealous in the face of an adversary who is mean, ugly, deceptive, and devious and the most subtle of all God's created beings.

The hardest thing to hear is that much of the "denominational" Indian Christians are very worldly. About 10 years ago American TV came into India and the corruption of the people began. Once (not long ago) one would never have seen near naked people on Indian TV, but today it is everywhere. Materialism and sexual perversion are taking over at a phenomenal rate. The deceitfulness of riches and love of money isn't an American thing, but because it is "beamed" from our world to godless people who are unable to resist, it is fast becoming an "Indian" thing.

The devastation of India in the recent earthquake and subsequent tsunami flooding shows us how much in need of the Lord they are in India. Hinduism and Buddhism are growing at breakneck speeds in America. That means that the result of paganism being introduced and entrenched in our world will be seen here too. We can't believe that satan will blithely sit by and not use the lost like pawns in a master game of chess. We know that God wins in the end, but we also know that we are accountable for what we do with the natural and spiritual resources He has entrusted us with.

When you pray, and you should be praying, remember Barnabas and the other fire-filled believers in India, China and Indonesia. Remember, what one part of the Body suffers we should all be willing to suffer. We should lift them up for Psalm 91 protection and 2 Corinthians 9:6-11 provision. What affects one part of a body will eventually affect it all.

It is our desire to help Barnabas go full-time with his evangelism. He has been chased by the Hindis and his wife and three tiny children are at risk every day of their lives. They don't preach in nice warm buildings, but much as the first century believers did, in houses huddled in corners. When they do preach in public it is at great bodily risk. They are summarily fired for no "apparent" reason, their children are forbidden from formal education and it grows more and more dangerous for them as more people become aware of their faith in Y'shua/Jesus and Abba Father.

When you consider sowing seed with us, know that it is our desire to help Barnabas get the word out in India. We sow into his life and the lives of other believers we are personally in contact with. We know these people; they labor in great hardship for the Body of Christ. There isn't much time left and when we think of the 40,000+ who lost their lives (and most likely are in hell at present) the burden grows heavy in our hearts.

PROSPERITY OF THE SOUL, VEXED

3 John 2 Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

How often do we hear this verse or read it and have no clue how vital it is to our lives? First let us remember who is writing it. It is our beloved John, the one who was boiled in oil and lived to testify to God's saving grace. He was finally exiled to the isle of Patmos where he would receive the Revelation of the Christ, the Messiah Y'shua for the last days. This man was not "clueless in Patmos", he was clued into the kingdom and hearing from the Father. Why? Because he had very few distractions in his captivity.

I don't like the English word "wish". It has connotations of witchcraft and I have no desire to partake in the fruits of the dark arts. If you go back to the Greek origins of this verse and look up wish it is actually "euchomai". It means to **pray** or to will. These words tell us that Brother John is praying and using his will for something to happen. It was his desire (as it is the Father's) for us to prosper and be in health, but our definition of prosperity today is corrupted by the world's definition of prosperity. Again, let's return to our text and its Greek origins. The word "prosper" here means to have a **good journey**. Of course "being in health" is pretty clear, but just to make it clearer I'll let you know it means to be sound or whole in body.

We have another word we need to understand and that is the word *soul*. The soul is the mind, the will and the emotions; the *psuche* of man.

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PROSPERITY OF SOUL......CONTINUED



Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health even as thy soul prospereth. 3 John 2

Bear with me as I paraphrase this verse with the new understanding we have gained by just a little research. "Beloved, I pray and will above all things that you might have a good journey in life and be sound and whole in body, in line with and in agreement with the prosperity of your soul; your mind, your will and your emotions". So how do we prosper or have a good journey in life? Something causes our minds, our wills and our emotions to prosper.

"Prov 23:7 For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he..." If we think we're sick, guess what happens? If we think we're evil, guess what happens? If we think we can't quit a bad habit, what will follow? If we believe we were made homosexual from birth, guess what happens? BUT, if we believe we're the righteousness of God in Christ what will follow? If we believe "by His stripes ye WERE healed" guess what happens? Some of this is review for many of you. You spend time in the word every day. You feed your spirit by renewing your mind as Romans tells us to do, BUT and again I say BUT, there is a caveat that we must be aware of.

"Rom 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God."

We're warned here not to be **conformed** to THIS world. What does this mean?

CONFORMED NT:4964

suschematizo (soos-khay-mat-id'-zo); from NT:4862 and a derivative of NT:4976; to fashion alike, i.e. conform to the same pattern (figuratively):KJV - conform to, fashion self according to.

CONFORMITY BY UNION NT:4862

sun (soon); a primary preposition denoting union; with or together (but much closer than NT:3326 or NT:3844), i.e. by association, companionship, process, resemblance, possession, instrumentality, addition, etc.: KJV - beside, with. In composition it has similar applications, including completeness.

Let's get an example of someone who was conformed to this world by association, companionship, process, resemblance, possession, instrumentality and addition and see his outcome. Shall we? 2 Peter 2:7-8... just Lot, vexed with the filthy conversation of the wicked: (For that righteous man dwelling among them, in seeing and hearing, vexed his righteous soul from day to day with their unlawful deeds...)" What was Lot's outcome? He lost his wife (she had been around the world just a little too long). He was ready to offer his daughters to foul sodomites. He lost his son-in-laws (not such a bad thing), because they too had been vexed to the place that they thought Sodom was a good safe place to live in. His daughters were so corrupted that they committed incest in order to "save themselves" and their posterity. YUCK. Was it worth it for Lot to associate and have companionship with the world? In the process of time he resembled the world and it took possession of him. "Mark 8:36 For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul?"

No matter how much we study, pray and walk the word, if we are camped next to Sodom and Gomorrah our souls are NOT going to prosper. Let me give you a parable and see if you can get a better picture. If you have a lovely field of tomatoes and you plant thorny mesquites in with them will you have a good harvest of tomatoes? If you plant peas with morning glories will you be able to have a good harvest? If you plant wheat and Johnson grass or Bermuda grass, just how much wheat will you be able to harvest to make bread? The Lord described a parable of wheat sown with tares. His servants wanted to rip up the tares that had been sown in with the wheat. The Lord said "no" and told them to wait until the harvest and then separate one from another. Now I understand this parable and see that the separation can be done, but guess what folks, it's going to take angels to make the distinction and do the job. It will also be at the bitter end of everything that the harvesting is done. We aren't angels and we don't have that sort of time. Not only that, Y'shua/Jesus told us that "an enemy" did the sowing. We don't want to be enemies and sow bad seed in with the good seed. You can't be

a friend and an enemy of God at the same time. You can't be a son of the devil and a son of God at the same time. We are not our own, we don't have the right to sow junk in our fields (our minds, wills and emotions).

It's not easy to avoid wickedness. It is tasty, it is attractive and alluring. It is pleasurable (for a season), but eventually it takes us captive and no matter how much "weeding" we do we won't be able to make the tares we've sown go away.

The TV is a bag of seed. It can be used as a distraction or on a few channels it can be a tool for God. Magazines are also bags of seed. Whatever reaches your mind, your will and your emotions through the gates in your body (eyes, ears, nose) they is seed.

I will leave you with this thought: "Heb 5:14But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil." You can exercise your senses to discern good and evil, but it requires that you are of full age and capable of eating the strong meat of the word. Most of us are still at the place where we desire the "sincere milk of the word". We shouldn't be exposing ourselves to the things that daily vex our righteous souls. We will never "have a good journey or be sound and whole in body" if our souls are continually vexed.

DON'T BE FOUND OUT OF THE WAY WORKING OUT WITH JEFF

Rom 3:19-23 Now we know that whatever the Law (Torah) says, it speaks to those who are under the Law (Torah), so that every mouth may be closed and all the world may become accountable to God; because by the works of the Law (Torah) no flesh will be justified in His sight; for through the Law (Torah) comes the knowledge of sin. But now apart from the Law (Torah) the righteousness of God has been manifested, being witnessed by the Law (Torah) and the Prophets, even the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all those who believe; for there is no distinction; for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God...



Should I start from the end of these verses and go backwards or begin at the beginning and come to the end? Either way we get the same understanding so let's begin at the beginning.

Who does the law (Torah) speak to? Those who are under the law (Torah), the entire world and all that live in it. Every person reading this has been found guilty of sin before a righteous God because of what the law (Torah) says. The whole world has become accountable to God simply because of what the law (Torah) says. What does the Torah say? It says this is sin if you do it and that is sin if you don't do it. It shouts out at all that claim to live by it "YOU CAN'T LIVE BY ME"! The same Torah that so many born-again people seem to now claim that they and everyone else need to observe to please God, have walked away from the freedom Paul says we have in Christ as new creatures. Don't you think Paul knew a little about this subject? Living under the Torah I am talking about. He claimed to be a Pharisee above all Pharisees, a man not to be reckoned with in the scriptures. He lived by the Torah he loved for all of his life before he was changed into a new creation, he was now a living soul not a dead one. The same breath that God breathed into Adam was now making Paul a living soul. That did not happen because Paul knew and observed Torah, it happened because he believed in the FINAL sacrifice God made for all who would receive Him through Jesus. He was filled with the only life giving Spirit and became a new creature never before seen on earth. He understood that the only kind of man that could observe Torah without failure was a God-man. Paul understood it was Jesus that had finished all the work that man was unable to while living under the Torah. No one was righteous no not one! The Torah was given and it proved all mankind were in sin and in need of a Savior. Which one of you reading this knew anything about Torah and the Prophets before you received Jesus as your Savior? How did you ever get born-again without knowing how to observe Passover? The person that led you to salvation didn't sit you down and teach you anything except the sin you were stuck with and the way to

stay out of hell. You believed and received and were born-again that moment it didn't take a year of parashot study for God to make you a new creature! If the gospel of Jesus Christ were rocket science no one would be born-again, especially not me. Paul tells us the gospel is so simple it confounds the wise. I believe for the most part that that is what is happening right before our eyes today in the Body of Christ. There are those of you who have become wise in your own eyes and the simplicity of the Gospel has confounded you. "Watch out", this is a wake up call so again I say "Watch out"! There is coming a day that God will turn those over to a reprobate mind that have received the truth and turned it into a lie:

Rom 1:21-25 For even though they knew God, they did not honor Him as God or give thanks, but they became futile in their speculations, and their foolish heart was darkened. Professing to be wise, they became fools, and exchanged the glory of the incorruptible God for an image in the form of corruptible man and of birds and four-footed animals and crawling creatures. Therefore God gave them over in the lusts of their hearts to impurity, so that their bodies would be dishonored among them. They exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen.

As I write this we are living in the day described here, in fact we have been here for two thousand years. But we can readily see people now say they can please God without faith. Well you and I both know that is not possible. There is only one way to please God and that is by faith. Paul told us and he ought to know, Torah is not of faith:

Gal 3:10-13 For as many of you that are of the works of the law are under the curse; for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who does not continue in ALL things which are written in the book of the law, to do them." But that no one is justified by the law in the sight of God is evident, for "the just shall live by faith." Yet the law is not of faith!

In other words it is impossible to live under the Torah law and anyone who wants to be is living in a cursed condition because no one can keep **ALL** of the Torah law and if you keep some of it you must keep **ALL** of it. And because that is not possible for anyone on earth everyone on earth is in need of someone that can and did, and that was and is Jesus, the final sacrifice! He is THE ONLY WAY, He said so Himself, but lets not forget that He said also few there will be that find that way. It's becoming clearer the reason few truly find that ONLY WAY...it's because some of you want to make you own way and REALLY please God, that is not going to happen and those of you who fit that description are in for a really rude awakening if you don't begin to look for and find repentance from your dead works.

Gal 3: 12 Yet the law is not of faith! Heb 11:6 without faith it is impossible to please God. If you have become a person professing yourself to be wise you have become a fool and are in serious need of turning to Jesus as the only way.

tears to flow repeatedly. We really have no idea how precious a commodity forgiveness is until we need it and can't necessarily find it. Even if we find it, forgiveness doesn't stop the wound our sin caused from forming. Let me illustrate.

Last month I was asked to share on a given subject at a meeting. As the day of the meeting approached it became crystal clear that God didn't want me to teach on the subject. It wasn't because I was ignorant or unprepared to speak on the subject, but that in sharing what I knew I would hurt a sister who had also been asked to bring forth something on the same subject. I had even shared with Jeff that I wasn't supposed to say anything. So much for being submitted to God and my husband. It's hard to type these words. I still don't know where I stand with the sister I hurt or where my sister stands today. Being on such rocky soil is precarious at best. I do share this to let you know that as you mature you will still make mistakes and that some will be very costly. If my confession of failure might help one of you, I willingly open myself up for your benefit.

The night of the meeting we were all gathered to hear about what the first sister had to share. In blunders the "elephant". Like a huge behemoth I dumped my load of information. The hurt on the sister's face was apparent, but only I could see and feel her pain. She was so gracious, but so crushed. The damage was done and there was clearly no "undoing" that would fix what I had done. For a couple of days the Lord dealt with me and showed me just exactly what I had done. He also told me to send an apology. All I could see was the hurt and damage I had caused. I realized I had no guarantee that I would be forgiven. Whether I was forgiven or not, my interest continued to be how healing could be ministered to my victim.

Sometimes humility is a quiet thing, but sometimes it is a loud cry of despair. God really does love us very personally. He takes it seriously when His children are mean and obnoxious to one another. He won't put up with it and as we mature we can't put up with it within ourselves. Learn this before you hurt someone; being right isn't important, doing right is. Love is the most important thing. We should follow after it at all costs. Not some mushy fairy tale love, but love born in loving others above and before yourself. Forgiveness is never to be taken for granted. Even if we receive it, we should be slow to do things that require it. It's bad enough to put a nail in the body of our Lord because his suffering is over, but to pierce a brother or sister should be unbearable to us.

TOO BUSY TO LIVE?

While writing to a brother in the Body, the Father spoke these words: "Are you too busy to live"? He then reminded me that His words are **spirit** and they are **LIFE**. If we don't spend time in His words and listening to His voice via the Holy Spirit, we won't have **ETERNAL LIFE** flowing through us. We as humans have a tendency to work at work and not live life. Matt 6:25 Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment?

Back before we were asked by God to serve Him we focused everyday on "making a living". We worried about where the money for each and every bill would come from. When the taxes were due we stressed over them. We used credit cards like they were our life preservers and necessary things. When we began to walk the faith walk according to the word of God, things began to change. It was no longer our daily plan to work to make money, but our focus changed to establishing the Kingdom of God in our lives. That meant our focus was first to be on Abba Father and righteousness or rightstanding with Him. He told us through His Son Y'shua/Jesus that we were to "seek first" the kingdom of God. The kingdom of God is: "righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit". Day by day we began to implement this into our lives. At first it was as foreign as Jupiter, but it has become easier and easier. Why? Because God is faithful. We haven't gone a single day without a house to live in, food in our tummies or clothes on our backs. Sure we get tempted (the devil doesn't voluntarily lay down for anyone), but we're determined to keep our focus on the Father and His kingdom.

We want to encourage each and every one of you to lay down the idea of making a living and take up living life, the abundant life. This doesn't mean you're supposed to quit your job and just sit around and read your bible, but begin by believing that everything you do is to be done by faith. Begin practicing (when you're tempted to worry) focusing on righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit. Ask God about righteousness. Ask God about His peace. Ask God about His joy. Begin by remembering that everything around you is temporary and your focus is to be on the eternal. You may have to make some adjustments and learn to really think differently, but it sure beats the old way of doing things. Are you "too busy to live"?
