selves, but to build up the ones who have weaknesses. Each of us has strengths and each of us has weaknesses. The world is like a clutch of hens pecking on the head of a sick hen. Eventually they will kill it. The body of Christ (Messiah) is supposed to be 180 degrees different than the world. We make exchange of the things we are weak in and the things we are strong in for a reason. If a strong person protects a smart but weakly person, the two are benefited. The strong person gains the understanding of the smart person and the smart person gains the protection of the strong person. This is what we call "symbiotic". The world is a parasitical society. It sucks the life of its host and goes onto another victim. We are not to be like minded. We aren't supposed to focus on our own needs, but trust that by supplying the needs of the lesser brother/sister our needs shall be met by God.

James 5:16 Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

This is what we want, effective fervent prayer that will bring the things we all need from heaven. We are learning to walk in our righteousness (that Y'shua bought with his blood) and we are learning how to pray with effective fervor! We count it a privilege to pray for you and with you. Strongholds of the Adversary



It is our heart to see the Body of Christ (the Anointing) walk prosperously and full of health. If one were to judge things by how they look naturally, things in the Body look pretty bad. Folks are sick, poor, and bound by the adversary. This isn't how Y'shua/Jesus left us. He left his disciples full of power and authority. What is the difference between them and us? They were Hebrew men who knew the Torah, the writings of the prophets **AND** the Holy Spirit. They worshipped God in spirit and in truth. What does this mean? The spirit is the Holy Spirit and the truth is the Torah and the prophets.

These men were lead by the Spirit of God, but knew the Torah well enough to be able to weigh what they heard in their hearts and minds against the truth in God's word. The worship of God in spirit and truth is just like a perfect balance. The Holy Spirit will NEVER lead you away from the Word of God. The Word of God will never go against His Spirit! If you walk in both you can have confidence that you're in the center of God's perfect will.

Rom 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

The renewal of our minds is a continual perpetual process. This means we have to do it over and over much like we have to feed our bellies over and over. In the human state we are weakened by exposure to the wickedness of lust, sin and death. We need to run to the table of the Lord to be restored and renewed. We must go into His presence to receive the anointing to live. We must feed our spirits just as we feed our bodies. We must continually receive the Word of God as truth in place of what we've seen, heard, felt, smelled, tasted or thought. The carnal things of this world may be factual, but they aren't truth. Truth is eternal and never changing.

3 John 2 Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

The prosperity of the soul is to know God's voice (the Holy Spirit), to know His word (the Torah and prophets) and to obey. For instance, God told Noah "Build an ark". He didn't tell him the same thing He had told Abraham. He didn't ask him to sacrifice his son. He had a different plan for Noah. Noah heard God's voice and knew the word of God well enough to begin obeying. We're also told in the writings of the apostles that Noah was a preacher of righteousness. (2 Peter 2:5) He not only

built an ark, but he preached to the people around him. He knew that judgment was coming and he could see how many folks weren't going to make it through alive. For 120 years he obeyed God by building an ark and preaching righteousness. He didn't walk in his call for 5 years and give up because it was too hard. He didn't walk in his call for 20 years and give up because of persecution. He didn't obey God's voice for 50 years and give up because no one listened. He didn't build and preach for 100 years and stop because he was getting old. He finished his course by hearing God's voice and obeying.

If we look at Israel just after Moses died (a picture of the law being fulfilled in Y'shua/Jesus), we see a bunch of young men lead by two faithful holy elder men, Joshua (Y'shua) and Caleb. They had just been given the law (much like we as believers are receiving the engrafting of God's word upon our hearts). They were told "go in and possess the land". We're told we're supposed to follow these instructions.

1 Thess 4:4 That every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in sanctification and honour;

Before we can go in and possess the land we have to be sanctified (set apart for the Master's work). We must possess our own vessels (body, mind and spirit). The word used here "sanctification" means holiness or purity and the word "honor" which means dignity and of a high value. We are to be consecrated and dedicated to God, to Abba Father.

*James 1:27 Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to **keep himself** unspotted from the world.*

We are, according to Romans 12:2, to NOT BE CONFORMED (to look and act like) to this world. We can't have one foot in the world and one foot in heaven. We can't be DOUBLE-MINDED, one side good and one side evil. We are supposed to KEEP OURSELVES unspotted from the world. It can seem like an almost impossible goal because we are so surrounded by wickedness, but remember the little candle! In an entire darkened room a tiny candle can chase away the darkness so we can see our way out. With every temptation God makes a way of escape! Just keep your eyes on Him, on the Light and He will show us the way of escape. Let's begin to have a single vision of God's will as we listen for His Holy Spirit. We will find the way of escape from the temptations set before us and be able to soar above the negativity of this world!

Opposition to Love



Our greatest goal in life is to walk in God's love towards one another. The greatest opposition to this love walk is the evil spirits of **envy** and **strife** used by the adversary. As believers we first endeavor to obey God's word, we begin to step out and do things we've never been able to do before. Second we pull together in love and unity and WHAMO the adversary drops in some small divisive devil to interrupt the working of God, the working of love. We don't always recognize the enemy because he doesn't usually come dressed in a red union suit, wearing horns and carrying a pitchfork. He usually wears humans like he would wear a red union suit. He will stir up some crisis situation to confuse and misdirect us. He will get us mad at a brother/sister and then we are totally distracted from the great thing God is doing through us.

James 3:16 For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work.

Gen 3:1 Now the serpent was more subtle than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made.

The adversary hasn't changed his ways. He looks for subtle ways to maneuver into our lives and mess them up. So are the evil spirits he assigns to mess with us. We must remember that God set up order before the adversary brought in pride, chaos and

sin. He set up rank and order in the heavens and gave assignments. The adversary is a copycat. He doesn't have original ideas or he would be a creator. He is a destroyer so he takes creative, life giving things and copies them only in reverse. He is envious of our position as children of God. He still wants to usurp the throne of Y'shua/Jesus and ultimately the throne of God. He is the "overlord" of the darkness. He lords it over his subjects, first his fallen angels and demons and then over those who submit themselves to his rule. If we disobey the word we are under his subjectivity. He can do pretty much what he will with us. He can use us for a multitude of purposes, BUT if we follow Father God satan can't do a single thing with us.

Remember, God is love. He doesn't merely love, He IS love. He is every nuance, every facet, and every shade of love. The adversary is the antithesis of love, the opposite, the reciprocal or the antonym of love. He hates love.

How do we recognize when we're being used by the devil? Are we being selfish? Are our inner thoughts of self? Are we concerned with our own situation over someone else's? Are we attempting to save ourselves? This is how the devil acts. He is self-centered, self-absorbed, self-saving, self-exalting and self-adoring. God is always reaching out and spreading Himself to whosoever will receive Him. He is always working towards our best interests. He is a giver. His Son Y'shua was and is a giver. His Holy Spirit is a giver. His angels are givers. His children should be givers too. Whenever we are tempted to provide for ourselves, heal ourselves, make bread of stones for ourselves, protect ourselves we are being used by Mr. Subtlety.

Matt 16:24-26 Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me. For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: and whosoever will lose his life for my sake shall find it. For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?

Let's examine this closely. If we try to save our lives we will lose them, and if we sacrifice our lives God will give it back to us. Y'shua understood this principal and used it every step of the way. He did lose his natural life, but he got a whole lot more than his natural life in exchange. Let's also look at the consequences of trying to save our lives. It may feel like we're losing the whole world when we lay down our lives, our plan, but ultimately if we try to hold onto our lives we lose **everything**. Old satan forgets to mention this when he comes and tells us "You'd better strike back or you're going to get killed". He will tell us "If you don't sue this person, you'll lose everything". He'll tell us to really worry over a situation or else we'll lose control. If I'm honest with myself, I never had control in the first place.



The bullfighter is a great illustration of how satan works. He waves a red cape in front of an unsuspecting bull. The bull gets all worked up and flies at the cape. He has no clue the adversary is the guy holding the cape and that in the folds of the cape will ultimately be hidden a sword. The sword isn't the enemy, just the weapon of the enemy. The enemy is the guy brandishing the cape and sword. The bullfighter's goal is to work up the audience, to work up the bull and for his finale he will plunge the sword into the heart of the bull. Let's stay out of the ring. Let's realize that all those little daily irritations are nothing more than "red capes" and "swords". Let's make the decision to wrap ourselves up in the robes of righteousness behind the King of Glory and use the Sword of the Spirit to recognize and avoid the adversary from the "get go"!

The adversary was set on burning up the houses and ranches of several believers in that area. He also had his eye on the bible camp built up in Capitan. Working Out With Jeff

The Love of God



John 13:34-35

A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.

Any time you bring up the subject of love there will be people that add “yeah but” to their declarations of love. We all talk about walking in the fullness of God and all the anointing that God has for us in the body of Christ and yet we continue to allow this same thing to come up. We must begin to realize that the love walk is the most crucial thing in a believer's life. It is while we are walking in love one to another that the devil will try us and test us to see if we really are like Jesus. If he can get us out of love one for another, and that's exactly what he is attempting to do, then he knows he can come in to that situation and wreak havoc. If we stay in the love walk one to another, in the midst of the heat of the battle brought on by the devil we will always see God our Father come in and do what He promises in His word.

Have you ever considered why the love commandment of John 13:34-35 would be a NEW COMMANDMENT? Sure you have and I'll bet all of you have figured it out long ago. The love of God that Jesus is telling us to have one to another was not available to men before Jesus came and was sacrificed and resurrected. It was only then that the Holy Spirit could be given to men who would believe on His name. Then at that point the love of God was shed abroad in their hearts. Romans 5:5 Why? So they could obey this NEW COMMANDMENT. It would not be fair for Jesus to command us to do something that we could not do. The body of Christ must begin to develop and grow in the love one for another.

The love of God we should have one to another carries the power of God, the anointing of God just like the word of God carries the faith of God. If you don't intimately know the word of God in any area of life you will have no faith in that area. If you are not walking in the new commandment that Jesus gave us, “*Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another*” you will have no anointing and no power. This is not a suggestion from Him with the notion that if you would *like to* walk in love maybe things will go better. No! No! No! Read it again and again until you see past the traditions you may have established in this area. Remember “the traditions of man make the commandment of God of no effect”. (Matthew 15:6) This is a “NEW” commandment! I know what all the smart guys trying to help us to “understand things” are saying but they don't have a real revelation of the love of God or they would never say the things they are saying. They are being used by the devil in an attempt to take the power of God out of the body of Christ and replace it with rules and regulations. The devil would like to see the body of Christ with little or no anointing because he knows that it is the anointing that comes from love and unity that destroys his yoke Psalm 133:1-2 & Isaiah 10:27. So please watch for it. Anyone who is preaching another gospel (apart from the love gospel) we should run from. (Galatians 1:6-9) We're told “and let him be accursed”. And believe me if anyone denies that Jesus was, is, and always will be the Messiah that has already come in the flesh he is an unbeliever and we should have no fellowship with him. What does a person like that have that you should want? That person needs born again. It says very clearly that we are to love one another like He loved us and by that all the rest of the world will see that we are His disciples. The love you should have for the lost is something only a saved person can have. Lost folks have no love. God is love; there is no other love anywhere except in Him. So the love you have one for another is brother to brother. Showing the rest of the world the God kind of love proves that we are His disciples.

If you read what Paul wrote in 1st Corinthians in chapter 12 he is talking about the manifestation of the Spirit of God. The manifestation of the Spirit is singular here not manifestations. Paul is talking about one Spirit manifesting many different ways through people that will allow Him to do so. The body of Christ carries around the Spirit of God and when He, the Spirit of God sees that there is a need to manifest in a particular way he asks us to allow Him to through us. All the ways the Spirit of God can manifest are listed here in chapter 12 and they are dependent upon our love walk. All the ways the Spirit of God wants to manifest are subject to how we develop in this area of loving one another. Fast forward to the end of 1st Corinthians chapter 12 to verse 29.

Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Are all workers of miracles? Have all the gifts of healing? Do all speak with tongues? Do all interpret? But covet the best gifts: **and yet I show you a more excellent way!** At this point our bibles go into a different chapter but Paul didn't change his line of thought here; the more excellent way is the love of God. Check out all the different ways the Spirit of God wants to manifest in chapter 12 and then you should realize none of them will accomplish anything without love. I dare say none of them will even show up. The Spirit of God will not manifest if we are not developed in the love of God. We must begin to see the importance of this. If we begin to see the way the devil comes at us with strife and contention and recognize it we can use it to develop ourselves in the love walk. Let me give you what the Lord showed me. When we see that the Love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost we should be seeing things the way God sees things. He always sees things according to His word. When a man is walking in the love walk he sees things according to the word of God. A man walking in the love of God sees what he believes. When a man is not walking the love walk he believes what he sees and that is where all the works of the flesh come in. Can you begin to see the importance of this in our lives? We can all desire more manifestation of God's Spirit, more anointing in our lives but if we don't have the love walk developed we won't see them. Begin to study the word where it shows you what and how to walk in the NEW COMMANDMENT Jesus gave to us. Begin to develop yourselves in the love of God and no fear will ever be welcome there. Then people will begin seeing us as His disciples. Love you guys see ya next month.
