Do Not Panic Button

Special points of interest:

Recently I was headed to church on Sunday. About halfway between Gardendale and Midland I felt the urge to call a friend who I normally have Sunday lunch with. She informed me it was Shavuot (Pentecost) and she was going to services at the Messianic synagogue /congregation she attends. I suddenly knew in my heart I was to go with her. I made the shift of will in my heart and asked her if she would mind some company. She was glad to have me join her.

Once settled in my seat in the sanctuary I pulled out my journal to take notes. The teacher behind the pulpit is a friend and brother. He shared a short message about the unity of the Jew and Gentile believers in Yeshua/Jesus and the work of the Body. It was confirmation of what I've been studying and hearing from the Father in a capsulated version. I then went into the fellowship hall where they were serving lunch. I sat down with my food after conversing with some folks. A lady I didn't recognize came up and declared how good it was to see me. The Lord allowed me to minister to her in her situation. I was able to explain to her that when you pray in the spirit (in tongues) you bypass your head and therefore eat from the tree of life rather than from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. I taught the folks sitting around that table for about thirty minutes. Then they invited me to pray in the auditorium. There was such a strong burden for the Spirit of Elijah (repentance from dead works) to be released. In order for the word of the Lord to be received the heart must be prepared. (Have you won-

dered what the boots called, "the preparation of the gospel of peace" were for?" Before any great work of the Lord can be implemented God must send godly sorrow leading to repentance to His people. The preparation of the gospel of peace is vital for the hearts (spirits) of men to produce the fruits of the spirit. God always sends His grace for repentance before He expects His word to bear fruit. BUT He requires US to ask for godly sorrow and the grace to make **teshuvah** (repentance from dead works).

A young missionary from southern California who had just returned from Turkey heard my intercession and prophetic prayer. He came up to me. The spirit of prophecy came on me and the Lord gave him some clear instructions for what was ahead for him. We were both shaking from the heavy presence of the Lord. He went away with a clear plan for his call and his future!

The whole day was a sovereign work of the Lord. It was clearly a divine detour from my intended path.

As I type these words I'm reminded of Peter's explanation of what was happening on the day of Pentecost (Shavuot) after the Lord returned to heaven. He quoted the book of Joel making clear what God was doing. God will pour His Spirit upon all flesh as we speak His will. We have been given authority on planet earth. We are supposed to be putting the Lord's enemy under our feet. We are supposed to be doing "greater works" and destroying the works of the adversary. All creation continues to groan for the manifestation of the SONS of God, not just the SON of God! The ONLY way this will be done is as we hear HIS Voice, the Voice of the Holy Spirit and DO what He tells us to do. Sometimes God takes us clear out of our own way to do this. We have to be willing to take the detours He sends. If He tells us to go right, we must go right. IF He tells us to look for Mr. T, turn right, look for a green frog and knock on a door we need to be willing to do so. EVEN if it makes us look silly, feel stupid and go completely 180 degrees from where we NORMALLY go.

In the Garden of Eden the adversary laid a trap for mankind.
