Hearing the Voice of God.


Did that get your attention? Hope so!

adversary when you are in the way with him. Sure you're gonna sin! You can't help it while you're in flesh you inherited from Adam. That dirt bag you wear is full of sin. You on the other hand are the righteousness of God IN CHRIST. It has nothing to do with you or your abilities or disabilities. So run to God when you sin. That's the first thing. NEVER run from Him. Those in Christ are never condemned! Are you in Christ? If you've made him Lord of your life, you are. It's just that simple.

Joan of Arc was a woman who said she heard the voice of God. Who martyred her, but those who could NOT hear His voice? The Lord told us that HIS sheep hear HIS voice. So we should ask ourselves, if we're not hearing, why aren't we hearing?



The heart is the center or core of man. The heart is the spirit where all eternal life dwells and functions in human flesh. Proverbs says, "The spirit of man is the candle of the Lord, searching the inward parts of the belly". The spirit of man is where all the fruit of the spirit are produced. Galatians tells us that those fruit are: *Gal. 5:22-23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace,*



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*longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, 23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.* We must have a healthy heart or spirit in order to produce fruit. *Matthew 12: 35 A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things.*

I was amazed to find out how many times God mentions the prophecy of Isaiah 6:9 throughout the bible: *And he said, Go, and tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not; and see ye indeed, but perceive not. 10 Make the heart of this people fat, and make their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and convert, and be healed.*

If we study the parables of the sower sowing seed we'll see just how important the condition of our hearts is to the production of spiritual fruit. I've studied and shared the parable so many ways, but I'm just now getting revelation light on a basic foundational level. Our hearts have been wounded, broken, bruised, crushed and tainted by the world. But good news, God heals the broken hearted! We "harden" our hearts when we try to protect rather than "keep" our hearts. We in effect put a shell around our hearts to prevent ourselves from being wounded again.

*Ezekiel 11: 19 And I will give them one heart, and I will put a new spirit within you; and I will take the stony heart out of their flesh, and will give them an heart of flesh: 20 That they may walk in my statutes, and keep mine ordinances, and do them: and they shall be my people, and I will be their God.*

*Psalms 34: 18 The LORD is nigh (close) unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit.*

Again, if we approach the parable of the sower we see that there are several things



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that can influence or affect the heart of man.

♥ Unbelief (hearing but not doing) or ignorance of the word and its meaning

♥ Affliction and persecution because we must stand on the word

♥ Offense at the affliction and persecution

♥ Cares of this world

♥ Lust of other things (anything can become a god you put before God)

♥ Deceitfulness of riches (root of all evil severed by the tithe!)

♥ Pride of life (Read Deuteronomy 8)

All of these can be dealt with and overcome, but ignorance of these things can wield a death blow to any chance of going on in victory in the kingdom of God.

We have to start at the beginning just like anyone wanting to do a complete job of anything. We need the fundamentals, the basic ideas and principles in order to be sons and daughters (with any sort of power) of the Most High God. We can't skip the foundation and go straight to the walls. That would be fool-hearty. We're told that a fool builds on sand and a wise man builds upon bedrock. The word of

God is unchanging and it is the only thing that is true and eternal.



So we have broken hearts. Let's just stop there and be honest with ourselves, shall we? If you've ever had someone lie to you, betray you, trick you,

hurt you, reject you, or if you've fallen in love with stuff or found yourself mad at God and mistrusting Him your heart has been touched. We're told to "keep our hearts". That word keep is the old English word for a "keep" in a castle. The "keep" was the highest place on the castle wall. It gave the watchman the ability to see from all directions any enemy coming towards the castle. It's all about watching your heart.



If you go back to the things that affect the heart and that make it unreceptive to the word of God you'll see that the enemy uses the same things over and over. He isn't creative, he can only corrupt what God creates. I'm putting them here a second time because I believe every child of God needs to have these "traps" memorized. Must like a trapper marks the traps he sets so he won't put his "foot in



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it”, we need to learn to recognize the camouflaged snares the enemy sets for us.

♥ Unbelief (hearing but not acting upon)

♥ Ignorance of the word (simply not knowing God or His word)


♥ Affliction and persecution causing offense (any sort of offense)

♥ Cares or worries of this world (you’re supposed to cast them on God)

♥ Lust of other things (again even your pain can be an idol)

♥ Deceitfulness of riches (money answers everything, but isn’t THE answer to everything)

♥ Pride of life (by my own hands have I done this thing: error of Cain)

So how do we “keep” our hearts if we aren’t supposed to put shells around them? The first thing we need is to know we have access to the “full armor of God”. If

our hearts are located. The heart is at the core of man. The spirit is located in the center of your human body. You therefore would want to cover that with a piece of armor. Which piece of armor covers your heart? The breastplate of righteousness. Now I know that you can’t really “see” the full armor of God, but righteousness is a spiritual force. Even though it’s invisible to man’s naked eye, it’s very much a real thing. Everything natural was made with something spiritual. God’s word is a “spiritual creative force” and by it He created everything we “touch” with our natural senses. Being in right standing with God is powerful. If God be for us WHO can be against us? Nobody! So when you know that you are covered with righteousness that isn’t hurt by man’s words, deeds and etc. you don’t have to run from scary people, you are victorious over every situation. But on the other hand, if you are trying to be righteous by good deeds the enemy knows your righteousness is like a filthy old rag. He knows you are naked and he beats the living daylights out of you. When he convinces you to “do something to prove your righteousness” and he beats you silly, you will put up walls or shell around your heart. His whole plan is for you to close your eyes and ears to God. If he can do that he can stop the spiritual force of God’s word from working in your life.

We are in the last days. We still have a



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job to do. If we turn tail and run because we're afraid we might be hurt, God will have to slow down time so the work can be done by another generation. I personally don't want someone else doing my job. So let's present our hearts to God. We're told He will "keep" us in perfect (mature and complete) peace if we "keep" our minds stayed ("kept") on Him. You're going to be tempted to fear in a million ways. The whole methodology of the enemy in the last days is to stop us with terrorism of any sort. God hasn't given a spirit of fear to His children, but the Holy Spirit of power, love and a sound mind!

This article is for your survival and to equip you to become victorious. It is part of God's plan for the manifestation of His children in these last days.
